Foreword

The Quran repeatedly talks about Al-Ma'rûf, all that Islâm orders one to do and Al-Munkar, all that Islâm has forbidden. These dos and don'ts are the fundamental and essential parts of Islamic teachings, which have been made mandatory for our daily lives. As Allah says in chapter Al-e-Imran-104; 'Let there arise out of you a group of people inviting to all that is good in Islâm, enjoining Al-Ma'rûf and forbidding Al-Munkar.' And He intends His expectations from us in chapter Al-Hajj-41: 'If We give them power in the land, they enjoin Salât, pay the Zakât, enjoin Al-Ma'rûf, and forbid Al-Munkar.' Muslims' uniqueness in the sight of Allah is mentioned in chapter Al-Tawbah-71; 'The believers, men and women, are supporters of one another. They enjoin Al-Ma'rûf, and forbid from Al-Munkar.'

Allah has created death and life, so that He may test you as to which of you is better in his deeds (Al-Mulk-2). Every soul has to taste death. It is on the Day of Judgment that you shall be paid your rewards in full. So, whoever has been kept away from the Fire and admitted to Paradise has really succeeded. The worldly life is nothing but an illusionary enjoyment (Al-E-Imran-185).

Our routine life must be identical to these enjoined dos and don'ts and we need to correct our activities as and where required. This is the only way to ensure that we can be kept away from the Hell Fire and entered into Paradise. Death is continuously calling us towards our own grave i.e. either a garden from the gardens of Paradise or a pit from the pits of Hell (Sunan Tirmizi). We need to wake up now, before we slept forever in our graves that may be like a garden of paradise or a pit of Hell for us.

Allah says in Soorat Al-Asr: Man is indeed in a state of loss except those who believed, did righteous deeds, exhorted each other to follow the truth, and exhorted each other to observe patience. Out of these four mandatory criteria, we normally do not practice for exhorting each other to follow the truth of Quran. Mass distribution of Quran and its verses can also provide us a way to fulfill this mandatory requirement.

About This Book

This book contains almost all such verses or its parts that directly or indirectly deal with the fundamental Islamic teaching of dos (Al-Ma'rûf) and don'ts (Al-Munkar), and are applicable to all of us till Day of Resurrection. Original source of each verse is also mentioned, which has made it easier to follow the reference of context.

This book can be considered as an introduction to 'The Message of Quran'. The Message of Quran is a topic-wise classification of all the orderly verses of the Holy Quran along with related headlines on each paragraph. These headlines are also listed in the index of each part. The Message of Quran is separated into thirty parts, as the Holy Quran traditionally exists. This separation was intended only so that by reciting a part daily, we can complete the Holy Quran at least once in a month. Verses related to dos and don'ts in The Message of Quran have been written in bold. As The Message of Quran contains only English translation, hence ablution (wadu) is not necessary to read it. Contrary to the traditional translations, this distinctive format of The Message of Quran makes it more friendly-reading for a common book reader. It should be noted that this same Quran compilation is also published in Urdu as '*paighame quran*' and in Sindhi as '*quran jo paigham*'.

This book is not protected through any copy right; hence anyone can reprint and distribute it to get continuous reward in this world and hereafter. Allah Says in Al.Baqrah-261: The likeness of those who spend their wealth in the Way of Allah, is as the likeness of a grain (of corn); it grows seven ears, and each ear has a hundred grains. 8. Cleanliness

1. Purify your clothes and keep away from filth. Al-Muddathir-4,5

Mandatory Bath:

2. Approach not the prayer (AsSalat) when you are in a state of sexual impurity (Janaba), till you wash (bath) your whole body. Nisa-43
3. If you are in a state of Janaba (had a sexual discharge), purify yourself (by taking bath).

Ablution:

4. When you intend to offer the prayer (Salat), wash your faces and your hands (forearms) up to the elbows, rub (by passing wet hands over) your heads, and (wash) your feet up to ankles. Al-Meada-6

Tayammum:

5. If you are ill, on a journey or you come after answering the call of nature, or you have been (sexually) contacted with women and you find no water, perform Tayammum with clean earth and rub therewith your faces and hands. An-Nisa-43
6. But if you are ill or on a journey or any of you come from answering the call of nature, or you have been in contact with women (i.e. sexual intercourse) and you find no water, then perform Tayammum with clean earth and rub therewith your faces and hands. Al-Meada-6

9. Disbelievers and Hypocrites

1. If you obey those who were given the Scripture (Jews, Christians), they would indeed render you disbelievers. Aale Imran-100
2. Take not as your consultants, those outside your religion since they will not fail to do their best to corrupt you. They desire to harm you severely. Aale Imran-118

7. Take not the Jews and the Christians as Auliya (friends), they are but Auliya to one another. And if any amongst you takes them as Auliya, then surely he is one of them. Al-Meada-51
8. Take not for Auliya those who take your religion for a mockery and fun from among those who received the Scripture (Jews and Christians) before you, nor from among the disbelievers; and fear Allah if you indeed are true believers. Al-Meada-57
9. Those who disbelieve spend their wealth to hinder (men) from the Path of Allah, and so will they continue to spend it; but in the end it will become an anguish for them. Al-Anfal-36

Friendship:

16. They fight in Allah's Cause, so they kill (others) and are killed. At-Taubah-111
17. You shall be called to fight against a people given to great warfare, then you shall fight them. Al-Fath-16

18. Strive hard and fight in the Cause of Allah with your wealth and your lives. As-Saff-11

War-Booty

1. Whatever of war-booty that you may gain, verily one-fifth (20%) of it is assigned to Allah, and to the Messenger, and to the near relatives (of Muhammad SAW), the orphans, Al-Masakin (the poor) and the wayfarer. Al-Anfal-41
2. Enjoy what you have gotten of booty in war, lawful and good, and be afraid of Allah. Al-Anfal-69

Shaheed:

1. Think not of those who are killed in the Way of Allah as dead. Nay, they are alive with their Lord, and they have provision. Aale Imran-169
2. But those who are killed in the Way of Allah, He will never let their deeds be lost, Muhammad-4

Forbidden Fighting:

1. Do not fight at Masjid Al-Haram unless they start fighting you there. Al-Baqarah-191
2. If they withdraw from you, and fight not against you, and offer you peace, then Allah has opened no way for you against them. An-Nisa-90

Immigration:

1. Those who emigrated and were driven out of their homes, and suffered harm in My Cause, and who fought, and were killed, verily, I will remit from them their evil deeds and admit them into Gardens (Paradise). Aale Imran-195
2. He, who emigrates in the Cause of Allah, will find on earth many dwelling places and plenty to live by. An-Nisa-100
3. Those who believed, and emigrated and strove hard and fought with their property and their lives in the Cause of Allah as well as those who gave them asylum and help, - these are all allies to one another. Al-Anfal-72

3. Woe to curtailer who, when they measure something to receive from people, take it in full. Al-Mutaffifin-1,2
4. And when they measure something to give it to them, give less than due. Al-Mutaffifin-3

12. Food: Forbidden and Lawful

1. Eat of the lawful things that Allah has provided and be grateful to Allah. Al-Baqarah-172
2. Make not unlawful the Taiyibat (good things) which Allah has made lawful to you, and transgress not. Al-Meada-87
3. And eat of the things which Allah has provided for you, lawful and good, and fear Allah in whom you believe. Al-Meada-88
4. Eat of the good things with which We have provided you. Araf-160
5. Eat of the lawful and good food which Allah has provided for you. And be grateful for the Graces of Allah. An-Nahl-114
6. Eat from the good things We have provided to you, and do not exceed the limits in it, lest My anger should descend on you. Taha -81

Forbidden:

7. Allah has forbidden the dead animals, blood, the flesh of swine, and the animal which is slaughtered as a sacrifice for others than Allah. Baqarah-173
8. Forbidden to you (for food) are: Al-Maytatah (dead animals), blood, the flesh of swine, and the meat of that which has been slaughtered as a sacrifice for others than Allah, or has been slaughtered for idols, etc., or on which Allah's Name has not been mentioned while slaughtering, and that which has been killed by strangling, or by a violent blow, or by a headlong fall, or by the goring of horns - and that which has been (partly) eaten by a wild animal - unless you are able to slaughter it (before its death) and that which is sacrificed (slaughtered) on An-Nusub (stone altars). 13. Good and Evil

1. Let not be like those who covetously withhold of that which Allah has bestowed on them of His Bounty (Wealth). Nay, it will be worse for them; the things which they covetously withheld shall be tied to their necks like a collar on the Day of Resurrection. Aale Imran-180

6. Verily, Allah does not like anyone who is a betrayer of his trust, and indulges in crime. An-Nisa-107
7. There is no good in most of their secret talks. An-Nisa-114
8. And if the people of the towns had believed and had the Taqwa (piety), certainly, We should have opened for them blessings from the heaven and the earth. Al-Araf-96
9. He commands them for Al-Marooof and forbids them from Al-Munkar he allows them as lawful At-Taiyibat (good and lawful) and prohibits them as unlawful Al-Khabaith . Al-Araf- 157
10. We rescued those who forbade evil, but We seized those who did wrong with a severe torment because they used to rebel (disobey Allah). Al-Araf-165
11. We seal the hearts of the transgressors. Yunus-74
12. Allah will put the wrath on those who are heedless. Yunus-100
13. And defend evil with good. Ar-Rad-22
14. If they pass by some evil play or evil talk, they pass by it with dignity. Al-Furqan-72
15. And never would We destroy the towns unless the people thereof are wrongdoers. Al-Qasas-54
16. And do good as Allah has been good to you. Al-Qasas-77
17. Whosoever brings good, he shall have the better thereof. Qasas-84
18. Perform prayers, enjoin people for Al-Marooof, and forbid people from Al-Munkar, and bear with patience whatever befalls you. Luqman-17

19. And whoever submits his self to Allah and is good in deeds. Luqman-22
20. Allah knows the treachery of the eyes, and all that the breasts conceal. Al-Mumin-19
21. Good and evil are not equal. Repel (evil) with what is best, and you will see that the one you had mutual enmity with him will turn as if he were a close friend. HaMeem AsSajdah-34
22. Death upon those who make conjectures (against the true faith). Those who are drowned in ignorance, forgetful. Adh-Dhariyat-10,11
23. Keep your duty to Allah and fear Him as much as you can; listen and obey; and spend in charity; that is better for yourselves. At-Taghabun-16
24. A slanderer, going about with calumnies, one who prevents good, (and who is) transgressor, sinful, Al-Qalam-11,12
25. Harsh, and after all that, notorious. Al-Qalam-13
26. He used not to believe in Allah, the Most Great. And urged not on the feeding of needy person. Al-Haaqqa-33,34
27. And what may let you know what the steep course is? (It is) Freeing a neck of a slave, or giving food in a day of hunger (famine), to an orphan near of kin. Or to a needy person lying in dust. Balad-12-16
28. Who do good deeds only to show off and refuse to give even common necessities. Al-Maoun-6,7

Scoff, Suspicion, And Backbite:

1. No men should ever scoff other men. Nor should women scoff at other women, it may be that the latter are better than the former. Al-Hujraat-11
2. Nor defame one another, nor insult one another by nicknames. Al-Hujraat-11
3. Avoid much suspicion, indeed some suspicions are sins. Hujraat-12
4. And do not be curious, neither back bite one another. Would one of you like to eat the flesh of his dead brother? Al-Hujraat-12

Theft:

- Cut off (from the wrist joint) the (right) hand of the thieves, male or female, as a recompense for that which they committed. Meada-38

Idol:

- Refrain from the filth of the idols and refrain from a word of falsehood. Al-Hajj-30

Mistake:

- There is no sin on you in the mistake you make, but in that which you do with intention of your heart. Al-Ahzab-5

Majority:

- If you obey most of those on earth, they will mislead you far away from Allah's Path. Al-Anaam-116

Righteousness:

1. Those who believe, and do deeds of righteousness, and perform Salat, and give Zakat, they will have their reward with their Lord. On them shall be no fear, nor shall they grieve. Al-Baqarah-277
2. By no means shall you attain Al-Birr (righteousness), unless you spend (in Allah's Cause) of that which you love. Aale Imran-92
3. Allah loves the pious (Al-Muttaqoon). At-Taubah-7
4. Verily, the most honorable of you with Allah is the one who is the most pious of you. Al-Hujraat-12

Monarch:

- If We give them power in the land, they order for Iqamat-as-Salat, to pay the Zakat and they enjoin Al-Marooof, and forbid Al-Munkar. Al-Hajj-41

Counseling:

- When you hold secret counsel, do it not for sin and wrong-doing, and disobedience towards the Messenger but do it for righteousness and piety; and fear Allah unto Whom you shall be gathered. Al-Mujadila-9

2. The one who fears Allah will observe the advice. Al-Ala-10
3. But it (advice) will be avoided by the wretched, who will enter the great Fire. Al-Ala-11,12

News Verification:

- If a rebellious evil person comes to you with news, verify it, lest you harm people in ignorance, and afterwards you become regretful to what you have done. Al-Hujraat-6

Greeting:

- When you are greeted with a greeting, greet in return with what is better than it or (at least) return it equally. (Islamic greeting is: Assalamo Alaikum Wa Rahmatullah Wa Barkaatahu) An-Nisa-86

14. Grateful, Ungrateful and Patience

1. When harm touches man, he invokes Us, lying down on his side, or sitting or standing. But when We have removed his harm from him, he passes on his way as if he had never invoked Us for a harm that touched him! Yunus-12

Ungrateful:

9. And if We give man a taste of Mercy from Us, and then withdraw it from him, verily! He is despairing, ungrateful. Hud-9
10. But if you are thankless, verily! My Punishment is indeed severe. Ibrahim-7
11. Allah likes not any treacherous ingrate to Allah. Al-Hajj-38
12. Allah has created for you (the sense of) hearing, sight (eyes), and hearts (understanding). But little thanks you give. Al-Mumenoon-78

Patience:

3. They are those who are patient ones, those who are true, and obedient with sincere devotion in worship to Allah. Aale Imran-17
4. If you remain patient and become pious, not the least harm will their cunning do to you. Aale Imran-120
5. If you persevere patiently, and become pious then verily, that will be a determining factor in all affairs, and that is a great matter. Aale Imran-186
6. Endure and be more patient (than your enemy), and guard your territory by stationing army units permanently at the places from where the enemy can attack you, and fear Allah, so that you may be successful. Aale Imran-200 An-Nisa, The woman
7. Those who remain patient, seeking their Lords Countenance, perform Salat (Ar-Rad-22)
8. Those who remained patient, and put their trust in their Lord. An-Nahl-42
9. If you punish then punish them with the like of that with which you were afflicted. But if you endure patiently, verily, it is better for the patient ones. An-Nahl-126
10. Whose hearts are filled with fear when Allah is mentioned; who patiently bear whatever may befall them (of calamities); and who perform Salat, and who spend out of what We have provided them. Al-Hajj-35
11. Those who are patient, and put their trust only in their Lord. Al-Ankaboot-59

12. And verily, whosoever shows patience and forgives that would truly be from the things recommended by Allah. Ash-Shura-43

15. Hajj and Umrah

1. Perform the walking (Sa'ee) between Safa and Marwah during Hajj or Umrah. Al.Baqarah-158
2. Perform properly the Hajj and Umrah for Allah. Baqarah-196
3. Do not shave your heads until the Hady (animal) reaches the place of sacrifice. Al.Baqarah-196
4. If you cannot afford slaughter a Hady (animal), then fast of three days during the Hajj and of seven days when you returned home. Baqarah-196
5. Do not have sexual relations, nor commit sin, nor dispute unjustly during the Hajj. Al.Baqarah-197
6. There is no sin if you seek the Bounty (by trading etc.) of your Lord during pilgrimage Al.Baqarah-198
7. Hajj to the Kaabah is a duty that mankind owes to Allah, those who can afford the expenses. Aale Imran-97
8. Hunting is unlawful when you assume Ihram for Hajj or Umrah (pilgrimage). Al-Meada-1
9. Violate not the sanctity of the Symbols of Allah, or of the Sacred Month, or of the animals brought for sacrifice. Al-Meada-2
10. Kill not wild game while you are in a state of Ihram for Hajj or Umrah. And whosoever of you kills it intentionally, the penalty is an offering, brought to the Kabah, of an eatable animal equivalent to the one he killed, or, for expiation, he should feed Masakin (poor persons), or its equivalent in Saum (fasting). Al-Meada-95
11. To hunt and eat the flesh of the sea is made Lawful to you but to hunt on land is forbidden as long as you are in a state of Ihram. Al-Meada-96
12. It is neither their flesh nor their blood that reaches Allah, but what does reach Him is the taqwa. Al-Hajj-37

16. House and Home

1. Enter not houses other than your own, until you have asked permission and greeted those in them. An-Noor-27,
2. And if you find no one therein, still, enter not until permission has been given. And if you are asked to go back, go back, for it is purer for you. An-Noor-28
3. There is no sin on you that you enter (without taking permission) houses uninhabited when you have any interest in them. Noor-29
4. There is no restriction if you eat from your houses, or the houses of your fathers, or the houses of your mothers, or the houses of your brothers, or the houses of your sisters, or the houses of your fathers brothers, or the houses of your fathers sisters, or the houses of your mothers brothers, or the houses of your mothers sisters, or (from that) whereof you hold keys, or (from the house) of a friend. An-Noor-61
5. No sin on you whether you eat together or apart. An-Noor-61
6. When you enter the houses, greet one another with a greeting from Allah (As-Salamu Alaikum - peace be on you) blessed and good. An-Noor-61

17. Inheritance and Will

1. Make a reasonable bequest to parents and next of kin when death approaches to you. Al.Baqarah-180
2. Make a will that after your death; your wife should be provided one year's maintenance and residence without turning them out. Al.Baqarah-240
3. Allah commands you as regards your children (inheritance); to the male, a portion equal to that of two females; if (there are) only daughters, two or more, their share is two thirds of the inheritance; if only one, her share is half. For parents, a sixth share of inheritance to each if the deceased left children; if no children and the parents are the (only) heirs, the mother has a third; if the deceased left brothers or (sisters), the mother has a sixth. (The distribution in all cases is) after the payment of legacies he may have bequeathed or debts. An-Nisa-11
4. In that which your wives leave, your share is a half if they have no child; but if they leave a child, you get a fourth of that which they

leave after payment of legacies that they may have bequeathed as debt. An-Nisa-12

5. In that which you leave, their (your wives) share is a fourth if you leave no child; but if you leave a child, they get an eighth of that which you leave after payment of legacies that you may have bequeathed as debt. An-Nisa-12
6. If the man or woman whose inheritance is in question has left neither ascendants nor descendants, but has left a brother or a sister, each one of the two gets a sixth; but if more than two, they share in a third; after payment of legacies he (or she) may have bequeathed as debt, so that no loss is caused (to anyone). An-Nisa-12
13. Allah directs (thus) about Al-Kalalah (those who leave neither descendants nor ascendants as heirs). If it is a man that dies, leaving a sister, but no child, she shall have half the inheritance. If (such a deceased was) a woman, who left no child, her brother takes her inheritance. If there are two sisters, they shall have two-thirds of the inheritance; if there are brothers and sisters, the male will have twice the share of the female. An-Nisa-176
14. When death approaches any of you, and you make a bequest, then take the testimony of two just men. Al-Meada-106
15. You devour inheritance all with greed, and you love wealth with much love! Al-Fajr-19,20

18. Interest (Riba)

1. Those who eat Riba (usury) will not stand except like the standing of a person beaten by Satan leading him to insanity. So whosoever receives an admonition from his Lord and stops eating Riba (usury) shall not be punished for the past. But whoever returns (to Riba), such are the dwellers of the Fire - they will abide therein. Al-Baqarah-275
2. Be afraid of Allah and give up what remains (due to you) from Riba, if you are (really) believers. Al-Baqarah-278
3. Eat not Riba (usury) doubled and multiplied, but fear Allah that you may be successful. Aale Imran-130
4. And their taking of Riba (usury) though they were forbidden from taking it and their devouring of men's substance wrongfully. An-Nisa-161

5. Whatever Riba (increased amount) you give, so that it may increase in the wealth of the people, it does not increase with Allah; and whatever Zakah you give, seeking Allah's pleasure with it, it is such people who multiply. Al-Room-39

19. Islam, Religion and Sects

1. Allah has chosen for you the true religion. Die not except in the Faith of Islam. Baqarah-132
2. Take the color (religion) of Allah as no one can give a better color (religion) than Allah. Baqarah-138
3. Enter into Islam completely and do not follow the footsteps of Satan. Al-Baqarah-208
4. Do not exceed the limits in your religion, nor say of Allah except but the truth. An-Nisa-171

6. Follow the religion of Ibrahim and he was not of the Mushrikoon. An-Nahl-123
7. For every nation We have appointed religious ceremonies. Hajj-34
8. Perform As-Salat (prayers) and give Zakat: and that is the right religion. Al-Bayyina-5

Sects:

1. And hold fast, all of you together, to the Rope of Allah (Quran), and be not divided among yourselves. Aale Imran-103
2. Be not as those who divided and differed among themselves after the clear proofs had come to them. Aale Imran-105
3. With those who divide their religion and break up into sects, you have no concern in them in the least. Al-Anaam-159
4. We shall drag out from every sect all those who were worst in obstinate rebellion against Allah. Maryam-69
5. They have broken up and differed as regards their religion among themselves. Al-Ambiya-93
9. Those who split up their religion, and became sects, each sect rejoicing in that which is with it. Al-Room-32

10. You should establish religion, and make no divisions in it. Ash-Shura-13

20. Just and Unjust

1. Do not eat up one another's property unjustly. Al.Baqarah-188
2. Deal not unjustly and you shall not be dealt with unjustly. Al.Baqarah-279
3. Do not consume one another's wealth unjustly except it be a trade amongst you, by mutual consent. An-Nisa-29
4. You should render back the trusts to those, to whom they are due; and that when you judge between men, you judge with justice. An-Nisa-58
5. Stand out firmly for justice, as witnesses to Allah, even though it is against yourselves, or your parents, or your kin, be he rich or poor. An-Nisa-135
6. And let not the enmity and hatred of others make you avoid justice. Be just: Al-Meada-8
7. And if you judge, adjudge with justice between them. Verily, Allah loves those who act justly. Al-Meada-42
8. And turn not away those who invoke their Lord, morning and afternoon seeking His Face. You are accountable for them in nothing, and they are accountable for you in nothing, that you may turn them away and thus become of the Zalimoon (unjust). Al-Anaam-52
9. Give full measure and full weight with justice. We burden not any person, but that which he can bear. Al-Anaam-152
10. Who is more unjust than one who invents a lie against Allah or rejects His Ayat. Al-Araf-37
11. Give full measure when you measure, and weigh with a balance that is straight. Al-Isra-35
12. Give full measure, and cause no loss to others. Ash-Shuara-181
13. And weigh with the true and straight balance. Ash-Shuara-182
14. And do not cheat people by reducing their things, nor do evil, making corruption and mischief in the land. Ash-Shuara-183

15. Observe the weight with equity and do not make the balance deficient. Al-Rahman-9

21. Killing and Compensation

1. Shed not the blood of your people, nor turn out your own people from their dwellings. Baqarah-84
2. Qisas is prescribed for you in case of murder. Al.Baqarah-178
3. If the killer is forgiven by the brother of the killed against blood money, then adhering to it with fairness and payment of the blood money, to the heir, should be made in fairness. Al.Baqarah-178
4. And do not kill yourselves. An-Nisa-29
5. It is not for a believer to kill a believer except (that it be) by mistake. An-Nisa-92
6. And whosoever kills a believer by mistake, (it is ordained that) he must set free a believing slave and a compensation (blood money) be given to the deceased's family, unless they remit it. An-Nisa-92
7. And if he belonged to a people with whom you have a treaty of mutual alliance, compensation (blood money - Diya) must be paid to his family, and a believing slave must be freed. An-Nisa-92
8. And whoso finds this (freeing a slave) beyond his means, he must fast for two consecutive months in order to seek repentance from Allah. An-Nisa-92
9. And whoever kills a believer intentionally; his recompense is Hell to abide therein. An-Nisa-93
10. if anyone killed a person not in retaliation of murder, or (and) to spread mischief in the land - it would be as if he killed all mankind, and if anyone saved a life, it would be as if he saved the life of all mankind. Al-Meada-32
11. Life for life, eye for eye, nose for nose, ear for ear, tooth for tooth, and wounds equal for equal." But if anyone remits the retaliation by way of charity, it shall be for him expiation. Al-Meada-45

18. Nor they kill such life as Allah has forbidden, except for just cause. Al-Furqan-68

22. Life: Herein and Hereafter

1. Whoever desires a reward in this life of the world, then with Allah is the reward of this worldly life and of the Hereafter. An-Nisa-134
2. Those who deny Our Ayat and the Meeting in the Hereafter (Day of Resurrection,), vain are their deeds. Al-Araf-147
3. Verily, in the alternation of the night and the day and in all that Allah has created in the heavens and the earth are proofs for those people who keep their duty to Allah, and fear Him much. Yunus-6
4. Those who hope not for their meeting with Us, but are pleased and satisfied with the life of the present world, and those who are heedless of Our Ayat. Those, their abode will be the Fire. Yunus-7,8
5. Ruined indeed will be those who denied the meeting with Allah. Yunus-45
6. Whosoever desires the life of the world and its glitter; to them We shall pay in full their deeds therein, and they will have no diminution therein. Hud-15
7. The home of the Hereafter is the best for those who fear Allah and obey Him. Yusuf-109
8. Whoever wishes for the immediate (benefits from) life herein, We give him for whom We like. Then We shall appoint for him Hell. Al-Isra-18

20. The mutual rivalry for piling up of worldly things diverts you, until you visit the graves. At-Takathur-1,2

23. Mankind

1. Verily, the (human) self is inclined to evil, except when my Lord bestows His Mercy. Yusuf-53

2. Allah will not change the good condition of a people as long as they do not change their state of goodness themselves. Ar-Rad-11
3. Indeed, mankind is generally most unjust and ungrateful. Ibrahim34
4. It is only the men of understanding that pay heed. Ar-Rad-19
5. People pray for evil as they ought to pray for good. But people are hasty. Al-Isra-11
6. I (Allah) created the jinns and mankind for nothing else but to worship Me. Adh-Dhariyat-56
7. Indeed mankind is ungrateful to his Lord; Al-Adiyat-6
8. And verily, mankind is violent in the love of wealth. Al-Adiyat-8
9. Verily! Mankind is in loss, except those who believed and did righteous deeds, and exhorted each other to follow the truth and observe patience. Al-Asr-2,3

Poets:

- As for the poets, they are followed by the straying people. they say what they do not do. Al-Shuara-224,226

24. Matrimonial

1. He has created for you wives from among yourselves, so that you may find tranquility in them, and He has created love and kindness between you. Al-Room-21
2. (Lawful to you in marriage) are chaste women from the believers and chaste women from those who were given the Scripture (Jews and Christians). Al-Meada-5
3. Bad women are for bad men, and bad men are for bad women. Good women are for good men, and good men are for good women. An-Noor-26
4. Marry those among you who are single and also marry the pious of your male and female slaves. If they be poor, Allah will enrich them out of His Bounty. An-Noor-32
5. And let those who find not the financial means for marriage keep themselves chaste, until Allah enriches them of His Bounty. An-Noor-33

6. No difficulty to the believers in respect of (the marriage of) the wives of their adopted sons when they have divorced them. Al-Ahzab-37
7. Mothers should breastfeed their children for two full years. Al.Baqarah-233

Righteous Men

1. And those who guard their private parts except with their wives and the (women slaves) whom their right hands possess, for (then) they are not to be blamed. Al-Maarij-29-30
2. Men are the protectors and maintainers of women, because Allah has made one of them to excel the other. An-Nisa-34

Righteous Women

1. The righteous women are devoutly obedient (to Allah and to their husbands), and guard in the husbands absence what Allah orders them to guard (their chastity, husband's property, etc.). An-Nisa-34
2. O Prophet! When believing women come to you to give you the Baia (pledge); that they will not associate anything in worship with Allah. Al-Mumtahina-12
3. That they will not steal, that they will not commit illegal sexual intercourse, that they will not kill their children. Al-Mumtahina-12
4. That they will not utter slander, intentionally forging falsehood (by making illegal children belonging to their husbands) Mumtahina-12
5. And that they will not disobey you in what is recognized (in Islam) then accept their Baia (pledge), and pray Allah to forgive them. Al-Mumtahina-12
6. It may be if he divorced you (all) that his Lord will give him instead of you, wives better than you, Muslims (who submit to Allah), believers, obedient to Allah, turning to Allah in repentance, worshipping Allah sincerely, fasting or emigrants (for Allah's sake), previously married and virgins. At-Tahrim-5

Emigrant Women:

1. When believing women come to you as emigrants, and if you ascertain that they are true believers, send them not back to the disbelievers, they are not lawful (wives) for the disbelievers nor are the disbelievers lawful (husbands) for them. Mumtahina-10
2. And there will be no sin on you to marry them if you have paid their Mahr to them. Al-Mumtahina-10

3. Likewise hold not the disbelieving women as wives. Mumtahina-10
4. Ask for (the return of) that which you have spent (as Mahr) and let them (disbelievers) ask back for that which they have spent. Al-Mumtahina-10

Polygamy:

1. And if you fear that you shall not be able to deal justly with the orphan girls, then marry (other) women of your choice, two or three, or four but if you fear that you shall not be able to deal justly (with them), then only one or (the captives and the slaves) that your right hands possess. That is nearer to prevent you from doing injustice. An-Nisa-3
2. If you intend to replace a wife by another and you have given one of them a great amount as Mahr, take not the least bit of it back. An-Nisa-20
3. You will never be able to do perfect justice between wives even if it is your ardent desire, so do not incline too much to one of them so as to leave the other hanging. An-Nisa-129

Marriage Forbidden:

1. Do not marry the polytheist women, unless they come to believe in Islam. Al.Baqarah-221
2. Do not give your daughters in marriage to polytheist men till they believe in Islam. Al.Baqarah-221
3. And marry not women whom your fathers married. An-Nisa-22
4. Forbidden to you (for marriage) are: your mothers, your daughters, your sisters, your fathers sisters, your mothers sisters, your brothers daughters, your sisters daughters, your foster mother who gave you suck, your foster milk suckling sisters, your wives mothers, your step daughters under your guardianship, born of your wives to whom you have gone in - but there is no sin on you if you have not gone in them (to marry their daughters), - the wives of your sons who (spring) from your own loins, and two sisters in wedlock at the same time. An-Nisa-23
5. Also (forbidden for marry are) women already married, except those (captives and slaves) whom your right hands possess. An-Nisa-24
6. Thus has Allah ordained for you. All others are lawful, provided you seek (them in marriage) with Mahr (bridal money) from your property, desiring chastity, not committing illegal sexual

intercourse, so with those of whom you have enjoyed sexual relations, give them their Mahr as prescribed. An-Nisa-24

Mahar (Marital Gift):

1. It is not lawful for men to take back any of their Mahr (bridal money) which they have given to their wives. Do not transgress the limits ordained by Allah. Al.Baqarah-229
2. If you divorce your wife before (sexually) touching her, then you have to pay half Mahr. Do not forget to be graceful to one another. Al.Baqarah-237
3. And give to the women (whom you marry) their Mahr with a good heart, but if they, of their own good pleasure, remit any part of it to you, take it, and enjoy it without fear of any harm. An-Nisa-4
4. You are forbidden to inherit women against their will, and you should not treat them with harshness, that you may take away part of the Mahr you have given them, unless they commit open illegal sexual intercourse. And live with them honorably. If you dislike them, it may be that you dislike a thing and Allah brings through it a great deal of good. An-Nisa-19

Sexual Activities:

1. And who guard their private parts except from their wives or from those (bondwomen who are) owned by their hands. Mumenoon-5,6
2. Nor they commit illegal sexual intercourse. Al-Furqan-68
3. Do not have sexual relation with your wives during their menses period until they are cleansed. Al.Baqarah-222
4. Your wives are your tilth. You may go to your tilth as you please. Al.Baqarah-223
5. Those who swear not to have sexual relation with their wives have four months of waiting. Therefore, if they revert back, Allah is Most-Forgiving, Very-Merciful. Al.Baqarah-226

Quarrel:

1. Women on whose part you see ill conduct, admonish them (first), (then) refuse to share their beds, (and lastly) beat them, but if they return to obedience, seek not against them. An-Nisa-34
2. If you fear a breach between them twain, appoint arbitrators, one from his family and the other from hers; if they both wish for peace, Allah will cause their reconciliation. An-Nisa-35

3. If a woman fears cruelty or desertion on her husband's part, there is no sin on them both if they make terms of peace between themselves; and making peace is better. An-Nisa-128
4. But if they separate (by divorce), Allah will provide abundance for every one of them from His Bounty. An-Nisa-130

Zihar:

1. Those of you who declare zihar against their wives (by saying to them "You are like my mother's back."), they cannot be their mothers. Al-Mujadila-2
2. Those of you who declare zihar against their wives, then retract what they said, obligated on them is the freeing of a slave or must fast two successive months or should feed sixty poor persons, before they touch each other. Al-Mujadila-3,4

Divorce:

1. It is not lawful for divorced women to conceal what Allah has created in their wombs. Al.Baqarah-228
2. When divorced women have fulfilled the term of their prescribed period, do not prevent them from marrying their former husbands. Al.Baqarah-232
3. The divorced women should be given something in accordance with the known fair standard. Al.Baqarah-241
4. Lodge them (the divorced women) where you dwell, according to your means. At-Talaq-6
5. And do not treat them in such a harmful way that they be obliged to leave. At-Talaq-6
6. And if they are pregnant, then spend on them till they deliver. At-Talaq-6
7. Then if they give suck to the children for you, give them their due payment. At-Talaq-6
8. Let the rich man spend according to his means, and the man whose resources are restricted, let him spend according to what Allah has given him. At-Talaq-7

Iddah (Waiting Period):

1. When you marry the believing women, and then divorce them before you have (sexually) touched them, then they have no obligation of any 'iddah' (waiting period) for you that you may

count. So give them (due) benefits, and release them in a pleasant manner. Al-Ahzab-49

2. Divorced women shall wait (as regards their marriage) for three menstrual periods. Al.Baqarah-228
3. Do not consummate the marriage until the term prescribed (iddah period) is fulfilled. Al.Baqarah-235
4. When you divorce women, divorce them at their Iddah (prescribed periods), and count (accurately) their Iddah (periods). At-Talaq-1
5. (During this iddah period), turn them not out of their (husbands) homes, nor shall they (themselves) leave, unless they come up with a clearly shameless act. At-Talaq-1
6. Then when they are about to fulfill their term appointed, either take them back in a good manner or part with them in a good manner. And take for witness two just persons. At-Talaq-2

Widow:

7. Widow should wait (as regards their marriage) for four months and ten days. Al.Baqarah-234

Pregnant:

8. And for those who are pregnant (whether they are divorced or their husbands are dead), their Iddah (prescribed period) is until they deliver. At-Talaq-4

Overage and Immature:

9. And those of your women as have passed the age of monthly courses and for those who have no courses (still immature) their Iddah (prescribed period) is three months likewise. At-Talaq-4,

Adultery

1. And those of your women, who commit illegal sexual intercourse, take the evidence of four witnesses from amongst you against them; and if they testify, confine them to houses until death comes to them or Allah ordains for them some (other) way. An-Nisa-15
2. And the two persons (man and woman) among you, who commit illegal sexual intercourse, punish them both. And if they repent and do righteous good deeds, leave them alone. An-Nisa-16
3. And (prophet) Lout said to his people: "Do you commit the worst sin such as none preceding you has committed in the Aa-lameen?"

You practice your lusts on men instead of women. Nay, but you are a people transgressing beyond bounds. Al-Araf-80-81

4. Do not even go close to adultery. It is indeed a shameful act, and an evil way to follow. Al-Isra-32
5. The woman and the man guilty of illegal sexual intercourse, flog each of them with a hundred stripes. An-Noor-2
6. The adulterer marries not but an adulteress or a Mushrikah and the adulteress none marries her except an adulterer or a Muskrik. An-Noor-3
7. And those who accuse chaste women, and produce not four witnesses, flog them with eighty stripes, and reject their testimony forever. An-Noor-4
8. And for those who accuse their wives, but have no witnesses except themselves, let the testimony of one of them be four testimonies by Allah that he is one of those who speak the truth. And the fifth (testimony) (should be) the invoking of the Curse of Allah on him if he be of those who tell a lie (against her). But it shall avert the punishment (of stoning to death) from her, if she bears witness four times by Allah, that he (her husband) is telling a lie. An-Noor-6,7,8
9. Surely, those who like that lewdness spread among the believers, for them there is painful punishment in this world and the Hereafter. An-Noor-19
10. Those who accuse a false charge against the chaste and believing women are cursed in this life and in the Hereafter. An-Noor-23

Slave Girls:

11. After they (slave-girls) have been taken in wedlock, if they commit illegal sexual intercourse, their punishment is half that for free (unmarried) women. An-Nisa-25

Modesty (Hijab)

1. Tell the believing men to lower their gaze and protect their private parts. An-Noor-30
2. And tell the believing women to lower their gaze and protect their private parts and not to show off their adornment. An-Noor-31
3. And not to reveal their adornment except to their husbands, their fathers, their husbands fathers, their sons, their husbands sons, their brothers or their brothers sons, or their sisters sons, or their women, or the female slaves whom their right hands possess, or old male

servants having no (sexual) urge, or small children who have no sense of the shame of sex. An-Noor-31

4. And let them not stamp their feet so as to reveal what they hide of their adornment. An-Noor-31
5. Let your legal slaves and slave-girls, and those among you who have not come to the age of puberty ask your permission (before they come to your presence) on three occasions; before Fajr (morning) prayer, and while you put off your clothes for the noonday (rest), and after the Isha (late-night) prayer. (These) three times are of privacy for you. An-Noor-58
6. Other than these times there is no sin on you or on them to move about, attending (helping) you each other. An-Noor-58
7. And when the children among you come to puberty, then let them (also) ask for permission, as those senior to them (in age). Noor-59
8. And those old women who have no hope for marriage, there is no sin on them, if they take off their (extra) clothes while they do not display their adornment. Still, that they refrain (even from this) is better for them. An-Noor-60
9. O Wives of the Prophet! do not be too soft in your speech, lest someone having disease in his heart, should develop fancies (about you); and do speak in an honorable manner. Al-Ahzab-32
10. And stay in your houses, and do not display your beauty like that of the times of ignorance. Al-Ahzab-33
11. O Prophet! Tell your wives and your daughters and the women of the believers that they should draw down their shawls over them. Al-Ahzab-59

25. Masjid and Ka'bah

1. Purify My House (Ka'abah) for those who are circumambulating it, staying here for itikaf, bowing or prostrating themselves in prayer. Baqarah-125
2. The Mosques of Allah shall be maintained only by those who believe in Allah and the Last Day; perform prayers, give Zakat and fear none but Allah. At-Taubah-18
3. Verily, the Mushrikoon (polytheists, idolaters, etc) are Najasun (impure). So let them not come near Al-Masjid-al-Haram (at Makkah) after this year. At-Taubah-28

4. We have made Masjid-ul-Haram for all men, where residents and visitors are all equal. Al-Hajj-25
5. Associate not anything (in worship) with Me, and sanctify My House for those who circumambulate it, and those who stand up for prayer, and those who bow, and make prostration. Al-Hajj-26
6. They must remove their dirt, and fulfill their vows, and make tawaf of the Ancient House. Al-Hajj-29
7. And the Masajid (mosques) belongs to Allah, so invoke not anyone along with Allah. Al-Jinn-18

26. Messengers

1. We make no distinction between one another of His Messengers. We hear, and we obey. (We seek) Your Forgiveness, our Lord, and to You is the return of all. Al-Baqarah-285
2. Indeed in the Messenger of Allah you have a good example to follow for him who hopes in Allah and the Last Day and remembers Allah much. Al-Ahzab-21
3. We blessed Dawud with Sulaiman. He was an excellent servant of Allah. Surely he was great in returning (to Us)! Sad-30
4. Indeed We have sent Our Messengers with clear proofs, and revealed with them the Scripture and the Balance (justice) that mankind may keep up justice. Al-Hadid-25
5. Fear Allah, and believe in His Messenger (Muhammad SAW). Al-Hadid-28
6. Whatsoever the Messenger (Muhammad SAW) gives you, take it, and whatsoever he forbids you, abstain from it, and fear Allah. Al-Hashr-7

27. Mishap and Mischief

1. They never lost heart for that which did befall them in Allah's Way, nor did they weaken nor degrade themselves. And Allah loves the patient ones. Aale Imran-146
2. What you suffered (of the disaster) on the day (of the battle of Uhud when) the two armies met, was by the leave of Allah, in order that He might test the believers. Aale Imran-166

3. Seek not mischief in the land. Verily, Allah likes not the mischief-makers. Al-Qasas-77
4. Who rebel not against the truth with pride and oppression in the land nor do mischief by committing crimes. Al-Qasas-83
5. Those who had rebelled in the lands and spread a lot of mischief therein. Al-Fajr-11,12

Harm & Aggression:

1. We shall certainly bear with patience all the hurt you may cause us, and in Allah (Alone) let those who trust, put their trust. Ibrahim-12
2. As for those who hurt believing men and women without their having done anything wrong, they shall bear the burden of slander and a manifest sin. Al-Ahzab 58
3. And when some hurt touches man, he cries to his Lord (Allah Alone), turning to Him in repentance, but when He bestows a favor upon him from Himself, he forgets that for which he cried for before, and he sets up rivals to Allah, in order to mislead others from His Path. Az-Zumar-8
4. And those who, when they are subjected to aggression, defend themselves. The recompense of evil is evil like it. Then the one who forgives and opts for compromise has his reward undertaken by Allah. Ash-Shura-39,40
5. And indeed whosoever takes revenge after he has suffered wrong, for such there is no way of blame against them. Ash-Shura-41
6. The way (of blame) is only against those who oppress men and wrongly rebel in the earth. Ash-Shura-42
7. Verily, man is created very impatient; Irritable when evil touches him; And niggardly when good touches him;- Al-Maarij-19-21

28. Oath and Covenant

1. Fulfill your promises when you make it. Al-Baqarah-177
2. Do not use the name of Allah an excuse in your oaths against your doing good. Al-Baqarah-224
3. Yes, whoever fulfils his pledge and fears Allah much; verily, then Allah loves those who are the pious. Aale Imran-76

4. Verily, those who purchase a small gain at the cost of Allahs Covenant and their oaths, they shall have no portion in the Hereafter (Paradise). Aale Imran-77
5. To those also with whom you have made a pledge (brotherhood), give them their due portion An-Nisa-33
6. Allah will not punish you for what is unintentional in your oaths. Al-Meada-89
7. But He will punish you for your deliberate oaths; for its expiation (a deliberate oath) feed ten Masakin (poor persons), on a scale of the average of that with which you feed your own families; or clothe them; or set free a slave. But whosoever cannot afford (that), then he should fast for three days. Al-Meada-89
8. And fulfill the Covenant of Allah, Al-Anaam-152
9. If you fear treachery from any people throw back (their covenant) to them (so as to be) on equal terms. Al-Anfal-58

(6) Allâh has set a seal on their hearts and on their hearings, (i.e. they are closed from accepting Allâh's Guidance), and on their eyes there is a covering. Theirs will be a great torment. (Al-Baqara-7)

4. Make not mischief on the earth

And of mankind, there are some (hypocrites) who say: "We believe in Allâh and the Last Day" while in fact they believe not. (8) They (think to) deceive Allâh and those who believe, while they only deceive themselves, and

perceive (it) not! (9) In their hearts is a disease (of doubt and hypocrisy) and Allâh has increased their disease. A painful torment is theirs because *they used to tell lies*. (10) And when it is said to them: "*Make not mischief on the earth*," they say: "We are only peacemakers." (11) Verily! They are the ones who make mischief, but they perceive not. (12) And when it is said to them (hypocrites): "Believe as the people (followers of Muhammad Peace be upon him, Al-Ansâr and Al-Muhajirûn) have believed," they say: "Shall we believe as the fools have believed?" Verily, they are the fools, but they know not (13) And when they meet those who believe, they say: "We believe," but when they are alone with their Shayâtin (devils - polytheists, hypocrites), they say: "Truly, we are with you; verily, we were but mocking." (14) Allâh mocks at them and gives them increase in their wrong-doings to wander blindly. (15) These are they *who have purchased error for guidance*, so their commerce was profitless. And they were not guided. (16) Their likeness is as the likeness of one who kindled a fire; then, when it lighted all around him, Allâh took away their light and left them in darkness. (So) they could not see. (17) *They are deaf, dumb, and blind*, so they return not (to the Right Path). (18) Or like a rainstorm from the sky, wherein is darkness, thunder, and lightning. They thrust their fingers in their ears to keep out the stunning thunderclap for fear of death. But Allâh ever encompasses the disbelievers (i.e. Allâh will gather them all together). (19) The lightning almost snatches away their sight, whenever it flashes for them, they walk therein, and when darkness covers them, they stand still. And if Allâh willed, He could have taken away their hearing and their sight. Certainly, Allâh has power over all things. (Al-Baqara-20)

5. Worship your Lord

O mankind! *Worship your Lord* (Allâh), Who created you and those who were before you so that *you may become Al-Muttaqûn* (the pious). (21) Who has made the earth a resting place for you, and the sky as a canopy, and sent down water (rain) from the sky and brought forth therewith fruits as a provision for you. Then *do not set up rivals unto Allâh* (in worship) while you know (that He Alone has the right to be worshipped). (Al-Baqara-22)

6. You can never produce a Sûrah of the like thereof

And if you (Arab pagans, Jews, and Christians) are in doubt concerning that which We have sent down (i.e. the Qur'ân) to Our slave (Muhammad Peace be upon him), then produce a Sûrah (chapter) of the like thereof and call your witnesses (supporters and helpers) besides Allâh, if you are truthful. (23) But if you do it not, and you can never do it, then *fear the Fire (Hell)* whose fuel is men and stones, prepared for the disbelievers. (Al-Baqara-24)

7. Those that believe and do righteous good deeds

And give glad tidings to those who believe and do righteous good deeds that for them will be Gardens under which rivers flow (Paradise). Every time they will be provided with a fruit there from, they will say: "This is what we were provided with before," and they will be given things in resemblance (i.e. in the same form but different in taste) and they shall have therein Azwâjun Mutahharatun (purified mates or wives), and they will abide therein forever. (Al-Baqara-25)

8. Who are the losers?

Verily, Allâh is not ashamed to set forth a parable even of a mosquito or so much more when it is bigger (or less when it is smaller) than it. And as for those who believe, they know that it is the Truth from their Lord, but as for those who disbelieve, they say: "What did Allâh intend by this parable?" By it He misleads many, and many He guides thereby. And He misleads thereby only those who are Al-Fâsiqûn (the rebellious, disobedient to Allâh). (26) *Those who break Allâh's Covenant after ratifying it*, and sever what Allâh has ordered to be joined (as regards Allâh's religion of Islâmic Monotheism, and to practice its legal laws on the earth and also as regards keeping good relations with kith and kin), and do mischief on earth, it is they who are the losers. (Al-Baqara-27)

9. Allah will again bring you to life.

How can you disbelieve in Allâh? Seeing that you were dead and He gave you life. Then He will give you death, then again will bring you to life (on the Day of Resurrection) and then unto Him you will return. (28) He it is who created for you all that is on earth. Then He rose over (Istawâ) towards the heaven and made them seven heavens and He is the All-Knower of everything. (Al-Baqara-29)

10. Allah taught Adam all the names

And (remember) when your Lord said to the angels: "Verily, I am going to place (mankind) generations after generations on earth." They said: "Will you place therein those *who will make mischief therein and shed blood*, - while *we glorify you with praises and thanks and sanctify You*." He (Allâh) said: "I know that which you do not know." (30) And He taught Adam all the names (of everything), then He showed them to the angels and said, "Tell Me the names of these if you are truthful." (31) They (angels) said: "Glory be to You, we have no knowledge except what you have taught us. Verily, it is you, the All-Knower, the All-Wise." (32) He said: "O Adam! Inform them of their names," and when he had informed them of their names, He said: "Did I not tell you that I know the Ghaib (unseen) in the heavens and the earth, and I know what you reveal and what you have been concealing?" (33) And (remember) when we said to the angels: "Prostrate yourselves before

Adam." And they prostrated except Iblīs (Satan), *he refused and was proud and was one of the disbelievers* (disobedient to Allāh) (Al-Baqara-34)

11. Earth is a dwelling place for a time

And We said: "O Adam! Dwell you and your wife in the Paradise and eat both of you freely with pleasure and delight, of things therein as wherever you will, but come not near this tree or you both will be of the Zâlimûn (wrong-doers)." (35) Then the Shaitân (Satan) made them slip therefrom (the Paradise), and got them out from that in which they were. We said: "Get you down, all, with enmity between yourselves. On earth will be a dwelling place for you and an enjoyment for a time." (36) Then Adam received from his Lord Words. And his Lord pardoned him (accepted his repentance). Verily, He is the One Who forgives (accepts repentance), the Most Merciful (37) We said: "Get down all of you from this place (the Paradise), then *whenever there comes to you Guidance from Me, and whoever follows My Guidance*, there shall be no fear on them, nor shall they grieve (38) *But those who disbelieve and belie Our Ayât* (proofs, evidences, verses, lessons, signs, revelations, etc.), *such are the dwellers of the Fire*, They shall abide therein forever. (Al-Baqara-39)

12. Mix not truth with falsehood

O Children of Israel! Remember My Favour which I bestowed upon you, and fulfill (your obligations to) My Covenant (with you) so that I fulfill (My Obligations to) your covenant (with Me), *and fear none but Me*. (40) And *believe in what I have sent down* (this Qur'ân), confirming that which is with you, [the Taurât (Torah) and the Injeel (Gospel)], and be not the first to disbelieve therein, and *buy not with My Verses a small price* (i.e. getting a small gain by selling My Verses), and fear Me and Me Alone.). (41) *And mix not truth with falsehood, nor conceal the truth* while you know (the truth) (42) *And perform As-Salât* (Iqâmat-as-Salât), and *give Zakât, and bow down* (or submit yourselves with obedience to Allāh) *along with Ar-Raki'ûn*. (43) Enjoin you Al-Birr (piety and righteousness and each and every act of obedience to Allāh) on the people and you forget (to practise it) yourselves, while you recite the Scripture [the Taurât (Torah)]! Have you then no sense? (44) *And seek help in patience and As-Salât (the prayer) and truly it is extremely heavy and hard except for Al-Khâshi'ûn* [i.e. the true believers in Allāh - those who obey Allāh with full submission, fear much from His Punishment, and believe in His Promise (Paradise,) and in His Warnings (Hell,)]. (45) (They are those) who are certain that they are going to meet their Lord, and that unto Him they are going to return. (Al-Baqara-46)

13. Allah bestowed upon Israelite

O Children of Israel! Remember My Favour which I bestowed upon you and that I preferred you to the 'Alamîn [mankind and jinn (of your time period, in the past)]. (47) And fear a Day (of Judgement) when a person shall not avail another, nor will intercession be accepted from him nor will compensation be taken from him nor will they be helped. (48)

14. Allah delivered from Pharaoh

And (remember) when we delivered you from Fir'aun's (Pharaoh) people, who were afflicting you with a horrible torment, killing your sons and sparing your women, and therein was a mighty trial from your Lord. (Al-Baqara-49)

15. Allah separated the sea for Israelite

And (remember) when we separated the sea for you and saved you and drowned Fir'aun's (Pharaoh) people while you were looking (at them, when the sea-water covered them). (50) And (remember) when we appointed for Mûsa (Moses) forty nights, and (in his absence) you took the calf (for worship), and you were Zâlimûn (polytheists and wrong-doers,) (51) Then after that We forgave you so that you might be grateful. (Al-Baqara-52)

16. By worshipping the calf

And (remember) when We gave Mûsa (Moses) the Scripture [the Taurât (Torah)] and the criterion (of right and wrong) so that you may be guided aright. (53) And (remember) when Mûsa (Moses) said to his people: "O my people! Verily, you have wronged yourselves by worshipping the calf. So *turn in repentance to your Creator* and kill yourselves (the innocent kill the wrongdoers among you), that will be better for you with your Creator." Then He accepted your repentance. Truly, He is the One who accepts repentance, the Most Merciful. (Al-Baqara-54)

17. We shall never believe till see Allah plainly

And (remember) when you said: "O Mûsa (Moses)! We shall never believe in you till we see Allâh plainly." But you were seized with a thunderbolt (lightning) while you were looking.(55) Then We raised you up after your death, so that you might be grateful. (Al-Baqara-56)

18. Sent down Al-Manna and the Quails

And We shaded you with clouds and sent down on you Al-Manna and the quails, (saying): "*Eat of the good lawful things We have provided for you,*" (but they rebelled). And they did not wrong Us but they wronged themselves. (57) And (remember) when We said: "Enter this town (Jerusalem) and eat bountifully therein with pleasure and delight wherever you wish, and enter the gate in prostration (or bowing with humility) *and*

say: 'Forgive us,' and We shall forgive you your sins and shall increase (reward) for the good-doers." (58) But those who did wrong changed the word from that which had been told to them for another, so We sent upon the wrong-doers Rijzan (a punishment) from the heaven because of their rebelling against Allâh's Obedience. (Al-Baqara-59)

19. Then gushed forth there from twelve springs

And (remember) when Mûsa (Moses) asked for water for his people, he said: "Strike the stone with your stick." Then gushed forth there from twelve springs. Each (group of) people knew its own place for water. *"Eat and drink of that which Allâh has provided and do not act corruptly, making mischief on the earth."* (Al-Baqara-60)

20. They killed the Prophets wrongfully

And (remember) when you said, "O Mûsa (Moses)! We cannot endure one kind of food. So invoke your Lord for us to bring forth for us of what the earth grows its herbs, its cucumbers, its Fûm (wheat or garlic), its lentils and its onions." He said, "Would you exchange that which is better for that which is lower? Go you down to any town and you shall find what you want!" And they were covered with humiliation and misery, and they drew on themselves the Wrath of Allâh. That was *because they used to disbelieve the Ayât* (proofs, evidences, verses, lessons, signs, revelations, etc.) *of Allâh* and killed the Prophets wrongfully. That was because they disobeyed and used to transgress the bounds (in their disobedience to Allâh, i.e. commit crimes and sins). (Al-Baqara-61)

21. Shall have reward with their Lord

Verily! Those who believe and those who are Jews and Christians, and Sabians, *whoever believes in Allâh and the Last Day and do righteous good deeds shall have their reward with their Lord, on them shall be no fear, nor shall they grieve* (62) And (O Children of Israel, remember) when We took your covenant and We raised above you the Mount (saying): *"Hold fast to that which We have given you, and remember that which is therein so that you may become Al-Muttaqûn (the pious)"*. (63) Then after that you turned away. Had it not been for the Grace and Mercy of Allâh upon you, indeed you would have been among the losers. (Al-Baqara-64)

22. "Be you monkeys, despised and rejected."

And indeed you knew those amongst you who transgressed in the matter of the Sabbath (i.e. Saturday). We said to them: "Be you monkeys, despised and rejected." (65) So We made this punishment an example to their own and to succeeding generations and a lesson to those who are Al-Muttaqûn (the pious). (Al-Baqara-66)

23. "Verily, Allâh commands you to slaughter a cow."

And (remember) when Mûsa (Moses) said to his people: "Verily, Allâh commands you that you slaughter a cow." They said, "Do you make fun of us?" He said, "*I take Allâh's Refuge from being among Al-Jâhilûn* (the ignorants or the foolish)." (67) They said, "Call upon your Lord for us that He may make plain to us what it is!" He said, "He says, 'Verily, it is a cow neither too old nor too young, but (it is) between the two conditions', so do what you are commanded." (68) They said, "Call upon your Lord for us to make plain to us its colour." He said, "He says, 'It is a yellow cow, bright in its colour, pleasing to the beholders'". (69) They said, "Call upon your Lord for us to make plain to us what it is. Verily to us all cows are alike, and surely, if Allâh wills, we will be guided." (70) He [Mûsa (Moses)] said, "He says, 'It is a cow neither trained to till the soil nor water the fields, sound, having no other colour except bright yellow.' "They said, "Now you have brought the truth." So they slaughtered it though they were near to not doing it. (Al-Baqara-71)

24. Your hearts were hardened as stones

And (remember) when you killed a man and fell into dispute among yourselves as to the crime. But Allâh brought forth that which you were hiding. (72) So we said: "Strike him (the dead man) with a piece of it (the cow)." Thus Allâh brings the dead to life and shows you His Ayât (proofs, evidences, verses, lessons, signs, revelations, etc.) so that you may understand. (73) Then, after that, *your hearts were hardened and became as stones or even worse in hardness*. And indeed, there are stones, out of which rivers gush forth, and indeed, there are of them (stones) which split asunder so that water flows from them, and indeed, there are of them (stones) which fall down for fear of Allâh. And Allâh is not unaware of what you do. (Al-Baqara-74)

25. They used to change Word of Allah

Do you (faithful believers) covet that they will believe in your religion inspite of the fact that a party of them (Jewish rabbis) used to hear the Word of Allâh [the Taurât (Torah)], then they used to change it knowingly after they understood it? (75) And when they (Jews) meet those who believe (Muslims), they say, "We believe", but when they meet one another in private, they say, "Shall you (Jews) tell them (Muslims) what Allâh has revealed to you [Jews, about the description and the qualities of Prophet Muhammad Peace be upon him , that which are written in the Taurât (Torah)], that they (Muslims) may argue with you (Jews) about it before your Lord?" Have you (Jews) then no understanding? (76) Know they (Jews)

not that Allâh knows what they conceal and what they reveal? (77) And there are among them (Jews) unlettered people, who know not the Book, but *they trust upon false desires and they but guess.* (78) Then woe to those who write the Book with their own hands and then say, "This is from Allâh," to purchase with it a little price! Woe to them for what their hands have written and woe to them for that they earn thereby. (79) And they (Jews) say, "The Fire (i.e. Hell-fire on the Day of Resurrection) shall not touch us but for a few numbered days." Say (O Muhammad Peace be upon him to them): "Have you taken a covenant from Allâh, so that Allâh will not break His Covenant? Or is it that you say of Allâh what you know not?" (80) Yes! Whosoever earns evil and his sin has surrounded him, they are dwellers of the Fire (i.e. Hell); they will dwell therein forever. (81) *And those who believe (in the Oneness of Allâh swt- Islâmic Monotheism) and do righteous good deeds, they are dwellers of Paradise,* they will dwell therein forever. (Al-Baqara-82)

26. Allah took a covenant from sons of Israel

And (remember) when We took a covenant from the Children of Israel, (saying): *Worship none but Allâh (Alone) and be dutiful and good to parents, and to kindred, and to orphans and Al-Masâkîn (the poor), and speak good to people* (i.e. enjoin righteousness and forbid evil, and say the truth about Muhammad Peace be upon him), and *perform As-Salât (Iqâmat-as-Salât), and give Zakât.* Then you slid back, except a few of you, while you are backsliders. (83) And (remember) when we took your covenant (saying): *Shed not the blood of your (people), nor turn out your own people from their dwellings.* Then, (this) you ratified and (to this) you bear witness. (84) After this, *it is you who kill one another and drive out a party of you from their homes, assist (their enemies) against them, in sin and transgression.* And if they come to you as captives, you ransom them, although their expulsion was forbidden to you. Then do you believe in a part of the Scripture and reject the rest? Then what is the recompense of those who do so among you, except disgrace in the life of this world, and on the Day of Resurrection they shall be consigned to the most grievous torment. And Allâh is not unaware of what you do. (85) *Those are they who have bought the life of this world at the price of the Hereafter.* Their torment shall not be lightened nor shall they be helped. (Al-Baqara-86)

27. Curse of Allâh on the disbelievers

And indeed, we gave Mûsa (Moses) the Book and followed him up with a succession of Messengers. And We gave 'Îsâ (Jesus), the son of Maryam (Mary), clear signs and supported him with Rûh-ul-Qudus [Jibrael (Gabriel) A.S.]. Is it that whenever there came to you a Messenger with what you yourselves desired not, you grew arrogant? Some you disbelieved and some you killed. (87) And they say, "Our hearts are wrapped (i.e. do not hear or

understand Allâh's Word)." Nay, Allâh has cursed them for their disbelief, so little is that which they believe. (88) And when there came to them (the Jews), a Book (this Qur'ân) from Allâh confirming what is with them [the Taurât (Torah) and the Injeel (Gospel)], although aforetime they had invoked Allâh (for coming of Muhammad Peace be upon him) in order to gain victory over those who disbelieved, then when there came to them that which they had recognised, they disbelieved in it. So let the Curse of Allâh be on the disbelievers. (89) *How bad is that for which they have sold their own selves*, that they should disbelieve in that which Allâh has revealed (the Qur'ân), grudging that Allâh should reveal of His Grace unto whom He wills of His slaves. So they have drawn on themselves wrath upon wrath. And for the disbelievers, there is disgracing torment. (Al-Baqara-90)

28. "Believe in what Allâh has sent down,"

And when it is said to them (the Jews), "*Believe in what Allâh has sent down*," they say, "We believe in what was sent down to us." And they disbelieve in that which came after it, while it is the truth confirming what is with them. Say (O Muhammad Peace be upon him to them): "Why then have you killed the Prophets of Allâh aforetime, if you indeed have been believers?" (91) And indeed Mûsa (Moses) came to you with clear proofs, yet you worshipped the calf after he left, and you were Zâlimûn (polytheists and wrong-doers). (92) And (remember) when we took your covenant and we raised above you the Mount (saying), "Hold firmly to what we have given you and hear (Our Word). They said, "We have heard and disobeyed." And their hearts absorbed (the worship of) the calf because of their disbelief. Say: "Worst indeed is that which your faith enjoins on you if you are believers." (Al-Baqara-93)

29. Allâh is All-Seer of what they do

Say to (them): "If the home of the Hereafter with Allâh is indeed for you specially and not for others, of mankind, then long for death if you are truthful." (94) But they will never long for it because of what their hands have sent before them (i.e. what they have done). And Allâh is All-Aware of the Zâlimûn (polytheists and wrong-doers) (95) and verily, *you will find them (the Jews) the greediest of mankind for life* and (even greedier) than those who ascribe partners to Allâh (and do not believe in Resurrection - Majus, pagans, and idolaters). Every one of them wishes that he could be given a life of a thousand years. But the grant of such life will not save him even a little from (due) punishment. And Allâh is All-Seer of what they do. (Al-Baqara-96)

30. Allâh is an enemy to the disbelievers

Say (O Muhammad Peace be upon him): "Whoever is an enemy to Jibrael (Gabriel) (let him die in his fury), for indeed he has brought it (this Qur'ân)

down to your heart by Allâh's Permission, confirming what came before it [i.e. the Taurât (Torah) and the Injeel (Gospel)] and guidance and glad tidings for the believers. (97) *"Whoever is an enemy to Allâh, His Angels, His Messengers, Jibrael (Gabriel) and Mikael (Michael), then verily, Allâh is an enemy to the disbelievers."* (Al-Baqara-98)

31. We have sent down to you manifest Ayât

And indeed We have sent down to you manifest Ayât (these Verses of the Qur'ân which inform in detail about the news of the Jews and their secret intentions, etc.), and none disbelieve in them but Fâsiqûn (those who rebel against Allâh's Command). (99) Is it not (the case) that every time they make a covenant, some party among them throw it aside? Nay! (The truth) is most of them believe not. (100) And when there came to them a Messenger from Allâh (i.e. Muhammad Peace be upon him) confirming what was with them, a party of those who were given the Scripture *threw away the Book of Allâh behind their backs as if they did not know!* (Al-Baqara-101)

32. Disbelieving Shayâtin teaching magic to men

They followed what the Shayâtin (devils) gave out (falsely of the magic) in the lifetime of Sulaimân (Solomon). Sulaimân did not disbelieve, but the *Shayâtin (devils) disbelieved, teaching men magic* and such things that came down at Babylon to the two (angels,) Hârût and Mârût, but neither of these two angels taught anyone (such things) till they had said, "We are only for trial, so disbelieve not (by learning this magic from us)." And from these (angels) *people learn that by which they cause separation between man and his wife*, but they could not thus harm anyone except by Allâh's Leave. *And they learn that which harms them and profits them not.* And indeed they knew that the *buyers of it (magic) would have no share in the Hereafter.* And how bad indeed was that for which they sold their own selves, if they but knew. (102) *And if they had believed and guarded themselves from evil and kept their duty to Allâh, far better would have been the reward from their Lord,* if they but knew! (Al-Baqara-103)

33. Allâh chooses for His Mercy whom He wills

O you who believe! Say not (to the Messenger Peace be upon him) Râ'ina but say Unzurna (make us understand) and hear. And for the disbelievers there is a painful torment. (104) Neither those who disbelieve among the people of the Scripture (Jews and Christians) nor Al-Mushrikûn (the idolaters, polytheists, disbelievers in the Oneness of Allâh, pagans, etc.) like that there should be sent down unto you any good from your Lord. But Allâh chooses for His Mercy whom He wills. And Allâh is the Owner of Great Bounty. (Al-Baqara-105)

34. Besides Allâh you have neither any Walî nor any helper

Whatever a Verse (revelation) do We abrogate or cause to be forgotten, We bring a better one or similar to it. Know you not that Allâh is able to do all things? (106) Know you not that it is Allâh to Whom belongs the dominion of the heavens and the earth? *And besides Allâh you have neither any Walî (protector or guardian) nor any helper.* (Al-Baqara-107)

35. Allâh is All-Seer of what you do

Or do you want to ask your Messenger (Muhammad Peace be upon him) as Mûsa (Moses) was asked before (i.e. show us openly our Lord?) And he who changes Faith for disbelief, verily, he has gone astray from the Right Way. (108) Many of the people of the Scripture (Jews and Christians) wish that if they could turn you away as disbelievers after you have believed, out of envy from their own selves, even after the truth (that Muhammad Peace be upon him is Allâh's Messenger) has become manifest unto them. But forgive and overlook, till Allâh brings His Command. Verily, Allâh is Able to do all things. (109) *And perform As-Salât (Iqâmat-as-Salât), and give Zakât, and whatever of good (deeds that Allâh loves) you send forth for yourselves before you, you shall find it with Allâh.* Certainly, Allâh is All-Seer of what you do. (Al-Baqara-110)

36. Whoever submits himself to Allâh

And they say, "None shall enter Paradise unless he be a Jew or a Christian." These are their own desires. Say (O Muhammad Peace be upon him), "Produce your proof if you are truthful." (111) Yes, *but whoever submits his face (himself) to Allâh (i.e. follows Allâh's Religion of Islâmîc Monotheism) and he is a Muhsin then his reward is with his Lord (Allâh),* on such shall be no fear, nor shall they grieve. (Al-Baqara-112)

37. Allâh will judge between them

The Jews said that the Christians follow nothing (i.e. are not on the right religion); and the Christians said that the Jews follow nothing (i.e. are not on the right religion); though they both recite the Scripture. Like unto their word, said (the pagans) who know not. Allâh will judge between them on the Day of Resurrection about that wherein they have been differing. (Al-Baqara-113)

38. And who are more unjust

And who are more unjust than those who forbid that Allâh's Name be glorified and mentioned much (i.e. prayers and invocations, etc.) in Allâh's mosques and strive for their ruin? It was not fitting that such should themselves enter them (Allâh's Mosques) except in fear. For them there is

disgrace in this world, and they will have a great torment in the Hereafter. (Al-Baqara-114)

39. East and West belong to Allah

And to Allâh belong the east and the west, *so wherever you turn (yourselves or your faces) there is the Face of Allâh* (and He is High above, over His Throne). Surely! Allâh is All-Sufficient for His creatures' needs, All-Knowing. (Al-Baqara-115)

40. Allâh has not begotten a son

And they (Jews, Christians and pagans) say: Allâh has begotten a son (children or offspring). Glory be to Him (Exalted be He above all that they associate with Him). Nay, to Him belongs all that is in the heavens and on earth, and all surrender with obedience (in worship) to Him. (116) The Originator of the heavens and the earth. When He decrees a matter, He only says to it : "Be!" - and it is. (Al-Baqara-117)

41. Allah made plain the signs for believers

And those who have no knowledge say: "Why does not Allâh speak to us (face to face) or why does not a sign come to us?" So said the people before them words of similar import. Their hearts are alike, We have indeed made plain the signs for people who believe with certainty. (118) Verily, We have sent you (O Muhammad Peace be upon him) with the truth (Islâm), a bringer of glad tidings (for those who believe in what you brought, that they will enter Paradise) and a warner (for those who disbelieve in what you brought, they will enter the Hell-fire). And you will not be asked about the dwellers of the blazing Fire. (Al-Baqara-119)

42. Jews & Christians will never pleased with Muslims

Never will the Jews nor the Christians be pleased with you (O Muhammad Peace be upon him) *till you follow their religion.* Say: "Verily, the Guidance of Allâh (i.e. Islâmic Monotheism) that is the (only) Guidance. *And if you* (O Muhammad Peace be upon him) *were to follow their (Jews and Christians) desires after what you have received of Knowledge (i.e. the Qur'ân), then you would have against Allâh neither any Walî (protector or guardian) nor any helper.* (120) Those (who embraced Islâm from Banî Israel) to whom We gave the Book [the Taurât (Torah)] [or those (Muhammad's Peace be upon him companions) to whom We have given the Book (the Qur'ân)] recite it (i.e. obey its orders and follow its teachings) as it should be recited (i.e. followed), they are the ones that believe therein. *And whoso disbelieves in it (the Qur'ân), those are they who are the losers.* (Tafsir Al-Qurtubî.) (Al-Baqara-121)

43. When no person shall avail another

O Children of Israel! Remember My Favour which I bestowed upon you and that I preferred you to the 'Alamîn (mankind and jinn) (of your time-period, in the past). (122) And fear the Day (of Judgement) when no person shall avail another, nor shall compensation be accepted from him, nor shall intercession be of use to him, nor shall they be helped. (Al-Baqara-123)

44. Ibrahim AS fulfilled commands of Allah

And (remember) when the Lord of Ibrâhim (Abraham) [i.e., Allâh] tried him with (certain) Commands, which he fulfilled. He (Allâh) said (to him), "Verily, I am going to make you Imam (a leader) for mankind (to follow you)." [Ibrâhim (Abraham)] said, "And of my offspring (to make leaders)." *(Allâh) said, "My Covenant (prophethood) includes not Zâlimûn* (polytheists and wrong-doers)." (Al-Baqara-124)

45. ka'bah is a place of safety

And (remember) when We made the House (the Ka'bah at Makkah) a place of resort for mankind and a place of safety. *And take you (people) the Maqâm (place) of Ibrâhim* (Abraham) [or the stone on which Ibrâhim (Abraham) A.S. stood while he was building the Ka'bah] *as a place of prayer* (for some of your prayers, e.g. two Rak'at after the Tawâf of the Ka'bah at Makkah), and We commanded Ibrâhim (Abraham) and Ismâ'il (Ishmael) that they should purify My House (the Ka'bah at Makkah) for those who are circumambulating it, or staying (I'tikâf), or bowing or prostrating themselves (there, in prayer). (Al-Baqara-125)

46. Allah leaves disbelievers in contentment for a while

And (remember) when Ibrâhim (Abraham) said, "My Lord, make this city (Makkah) a place of security and provide its people with fruits, such of them as believe in Allâh and the Last Day." He (Allâh) answered: "As for him who disbelieves, I shall leave him in contentment for a while, then I shall compel him to the torment of the Fire, and worst indeed is that destination!" (Al-Baqara-126)

47. Make us submissive unto You

And (remember) when Ibrâhim (Abraham) and (his son) Ismâ'il (Ishmael) were raising the foundations of the House (the Ka'bah at Makkah), (saying), "Our Lord! Accept (this service) from us. Verily! You are the All-Hearer, the All-Knower." (127) "Our Lord! And make us submissive unto You and of our offspring a nation submissive unto You, and show us our Manâsik (all the ceremonies of pilgrimage - Hajj and 'Umrah), *and accept our repentance*. Truly, You are the One Who accepts repentance, the Most Merciful. (128) "Our Lord! Send amongst them a Messenger of their own

(and indeed Allâh answered their invocation by sending Muhammad Peace be upon him), who shall recite unto them Your Verses and instruct them in the Book (this Qur'ân) and Al-Hikmah (full knowledge of the Islâmic laws and jurisprudence or wisdom or Prophethood), and purify them. Verily! You are the All-Mighty, the All-Wise." (Al-Baqara-129)

48. Who turns away from the religion of Ibrâhim

And who turns away from the religion of Ibrâhim (Abraham) (i.e. Islâmic Monotheism) except him who befools himself? Truly, We chose him in this world and verily, in the Hereafter he will be among the righteous. (130) When his Lord said to him, "Submit (i.e. be a Muslim)!" He said, *"I have submitted myself (as a Muslim) to the Lord of the 'Alamîn* (mankind, jinn and all that exists)." (Al-Baqara-131)

49. Die not except as Muslim

And this (submission to Allâh, Islâm) was enjoined by Ibrâhim (Abraham) upon his sons and by Ya'qûb (Jacob), (saying), "O my sons! Allâh has chosen for you the (true) religion, then die not except in the Faith of Islâm (as Muslims - Islâmic Monotheism)." (132) Or were you witnesses when death approached Ya'qûb (Jacob)? When he said unto his sons, "What will you worship after me?" They said, "We shall worship your Ilâh (God - Allâh), the Ilâh (God) of your fathers, Ibrâhim (Abraham), Ismâ'il (Ishmael), Ishâq (Isaac), One Ilâh (God), and to Him we submit (in Islâm)." (133) That was a nation who has passed away. They shall receive the reward of what they earned and you of what you earn. And you will not be asked of what they used to do (Al-Baqara-134)

50. Allâh is suffice for Muslim against non-muslims

And they say, "Be Jews or Christians, then you will be guided." Say (to them, O Muhammad Peace be upon him), "Nay, (We follow) only the religion of Ibrâhim (Abraham), Hanifa [Islâmic Monotheism, i.e. to worship none but Allâh (Alone)], and he was not of Al-Mushrikûn (those who worshipped others along with Allâh)." (135) Say (O Muslims), "We believe in Allâh and that which has been sent down to us and that which has been sent down to Ibrâhim (Abraham), Ismâ'il (Ishmael), Ishâq (Isaac), Ya'qûb (Jacob), and to Al-Asbât [the offspring twelve sons of Ya'qûb (Jacob)], and that which has been given to Mûsa (Moses) and Isâ (Jesus), and that which has been given to the Prophets from their Lord. We make no distinction between any of them, and to Him we have submitted (in Islâm)." (136) So if they believe in the like of that which you believe, then they are rightly guided, but if they turn away, then they are only in opposition. So Allâh will suffice for you against them. And He is the All-Hearer, the All-Knower. (Al-Baqara-137)

51. We are to be rewarded for our deeds

[Our Sibghah (religion) is] the Sibghah (Religion) of Allâh (Islâm) and which Sibghah (religion) can be better than Allâh's? *And we are His worshippers.* (138) Say (O Muhammad Peace be upon him to the Jews and Christians), "Dispute you with us about Allâh while He is our Lord and your Lord? And we are to be rewarded for our deeds and you for your deeds. *And we are sincere to Him* [in worship and obedience (i.e. we worship Him Alone and none else, and we obey His Orders).]" (Al-Baqara-139)

52. Who is unjust than he, who conceals the testimony?

Or say you that Ibrâhim (Abraham), Ismâ'il (Ishmael), Ishâque (Isaac), Ya'qûb (Jacob) and Al-Asbât [the offspring twelve sons of Ya'qûb (Jacob)] were Jews or Christians? Say, "Do you know better or does Allâh (knows better... that they all were Muslims)? *And who is more unjust than he who conceals the testimony* [i.e. to believe in Prophet Muhammad Peace be upon him when he comes, as is written in their Books.] *he has from Allâh?* And Allâh is not unaware of what you do." (140) That was a nation who has passed away. They shall receive the reward of what they earned, and you of what you earn. And you will not be asked of what they used to do. (Al-Baqara-141)

2. Made night as covering and day for livelihood

6. Have We not made the earth as a bed. 7. And the mountains as pegs? 8. And We have created you in pairs (male and female). 9. And have made your sleep as a thing for rest. 10. *And have made the night as a covering* 11. *And have made the day for livelihood.* 12. And We have built above you seven strong (heavens), 13. And have made (therein) a shining lamp (sun). 14. And have sent down from the rainy clouds abundant water. 15. That We may produce therewith corn and vegetations. 16. And gardens of thick growth. (An-Naba-16)

3. Heaven shall be opened

17. Verily, the Day of Decision is a fixed time, 18. The Day when the Trumpet will be blown, and you shall come forth in crowds (groups); 19. And the heaven shall be opened, and it will become as gates, 20. And the mountains shall be moved away from their places and they will be as if they were a mirage. (An-Naba-20)

4. Hell is a dwelling place for rebels

21. Truly, Hell is a place of ambush. 22. A dwelling place for the Taghoon (polytheists, disbelievers, criminals, etc.). 23. They will abide therein for ages, 24. Nothing cool they will taste therein, nor any drink. 25. Except boiling water, and dirty wound discharges. 26. An exact recompense (according to their evil crimes). 27. For verily, they used not to look for a reckoning. 28. But they belied Our Ayat (proofs, evidences, verses, lessons, signs, revelations, and that which Our Prophet (Peace be upon him) brought) completely. 29. And all things We have recorded in a Book. 30. So taste you (the results of your evil actions); no increase shall We give you, except in torment. (An-Naba-30)

5. Success will be for pious peoples.

31. Verily, for the Muttaqoon (pious), there will be a success (Paradise). 32. Gardens and grape yards; 33. and young full-breasted (mature) maidens of equal age. 34. And a full cup (of wine). 35. No Laghw (dirtiness) shall they hear therein, nor lying. 36. A reward from your Lord, an ample calculated gift. 37. (From) the Lord of the heavens and the earth, and whatsoever is in between them, the Most Beneficent none can dare to speak with Him (on the Day of Resurrection except after His Leave). (An-Naba-37)

6. Angels will stand forth in rows on that Day

38. The Day that Ar-Rooh (Gabriel) and the angels will stand forth in rows, none shall speak except him whom the Most Beneficent (Allah) allows, and he will speak what is right. 39. That is without doubt the True Day, so, whosoever wills, let him seek a place with (or a way to) His Lord (by obeying Him in this worldly life)! 40. Verily, We have warned you of a near torment, the Day when man will see that (the deeds) which his hands have sent forth, and the disbeliever will say: "Woe to me! Would that I were dust!" (An-Naba-40)

7. Some hearts that Day will shake with fear

An-Naziat (Those who drag forth): 1. By those (angels) who pull out (the souls of the disbelievers and the wicked) with great violence; 2. By those (angels) who gently take out (the souls of the believers); 3. And by those that swim along (i.e. angels or planets in their orbits, etc.). 4. And by those that press forward as in a race (i.e. the angels or stars or the horses, etc.). 5. And by those angels who arrange to do the Commands of their Lord, (so verily, you disbelievers will be called to account). 6. On the Day (when the first blowing of the Trumpet is blown), the earth and the mountains will shake violently (and everybody will die), 7. The second blowing of the Trumpet follows it (and everybody will be raised up). 8. Some hearts that Day will shake with fear and anxiety. 9. Their eyes cast down. (An-Naziat-9)

8. Warning for whosoever fears Allah

10. They say: "Shall we indeed be returned to our former state of life? 11. "Even after we are crumbled bones?" 12. They say: "It would in that case, be a return with loss!" 13. But only, it will be a single Zajrah (shout, blowing of the Trumpet)). 14. When, behold, they find themselves over the earth alive after their death, 15. Has there come to you the story of Moosa (Moses)? 16. When his Lord called him in the sacred valley of Toowa, 17. Go to Firaun (Pharaoh), verily, he has transgressed all bounds (in crimes, sins, polytheism, disbelief, etc.). 18. And say to him: "Would you purify yourself (from the sin of disbelief by becoming a believer)", 19. And that I guide you to your Lord, so you should fear Him? 20. Then (Moosa (Moses)) showed him the great sign (miracles). 21. But (Firaun (Pharaoh)) belied and disobeyed; 22. Then he turned his back, striving hard (against Allah). 23. Then he gathered his people and cried aloud, 24. Saying: "I am your lord, most high", 25. So Allah, seized him with punishment for his last and first transgression. 26. Verily, in this is an instructive admonition for whosoever fears Allah. (An-Naziat-26)

9. A provision for mankind and their cattle

27. Are you more difficult to create, or is the heaven that He constructed? 28. He raised its height, and He has equally ordered it, 29. Its night He covers with darkness, and its forenoon He brings out (with light). 30. And after that He spread the earth; 31. And brought forth there from its water and its pasture; 32. And the mountains He has fixed firmly. 33. To be a provision and benefit for you and your cattle. (An-Naziat-33)

10. Worldly life Preference leads to abode in Hell-fire.

34. But when there comes the greatest catastrophe (Doomsday). 35. The Day when man shall remember what he strove for, 36. And Hell-fire shall be made apparent in full view for every one who sees. 37. Then, for him who Tagha (evil deeds of disobedience to Allah). 38. And preferred the life of this world (by following his evil desires and lusts), 39. Verily, his abode will be Hell-fire; 40. But as for him who feared standing before his Lord, and restrained himself from impure evil desires, and lusts. 41. Verily, Paradise will be his abode. (An-Naziat-41)

11. Prophet is only a Warner for those who fear

42. They ask you (O Muhammad - Peace be upon him) about the Hour, - when will be its appointed time? 43. You have no knowledge to say anything about it, 44. To your Lord belongs (the knowledge of) the term thereof? 45. You are only a Warner for those who fear it, 46. The Day they see it, it will be as if they had not tarried in this world except an afternoon or a morning. (An-Naziat-46)

12. Quran is an admonition

Abasa (He Frowned): 1. (The Prophet (Peace be upon him)) frowned and turned away, 2. Because there came to him the blind man (i.e. Abdullah bin Umm-Maktoom, who came to the Prophet while he was preaching to Quraish chiefs). 3. But what could tell you that per chance he might become pure (from sins)? 4. Or that he might receive admonition, and that the admonition might profit him? 5. As for him who thinks himself self-sufficient, 6. To him you attend; 7. What does it matter to you if he will not become pure (from disbelief). 8. But as to him who came to you running. 9. And is afraid (of Allah and His Punishment), 10. Of him you are neglectful and divert your attention to another, 11. Nay, (do not do like this), indeed it (Quran) is an admonition, 12. So whoever wills, let him pay attention to it. 13. (It is) in Records held (greatly) in honor (Al-Lauh Al-Mahfooz). 14. Exalted (in dignity), purified. 15. In the hands of scribes (angels). 16. Honorable and obedient. (Abasa-16)

13. Let man look at his food

17. Be cursed (the disbelieving) man! How ungrateful he is! 18. From what thing did He create him? 19. From Nutfah (semen drops) He created him, and then set him in due proportion; 20. Then He makes the Path easy for him; 21. Then He causes him to die, and puts him in his grave; 22. Then, when it is His Will, He will resurrect him (again). 23. Nay, but (man) has not done what He commanded him. 24. Then let man look at his food, 25. That We pour forth water in abundance, 26. And We split the earth in clefts, 27. And We cause therein the grain to grow. 28. And grapes and clover plants. 29. And olives and date-palms. 30. And gardens, dense with many trees. 31. And fruits and Abba (herbage, etc), 32. to be a provision and benefit for you and your cattle. (Abasa-32)

14. When peoples will flee from their kin

33. Then, when there comes As-Sakh-khah (the Day of Resurrections second blowing of Trumpet), 34. That Day shall a man flee from his brother. 35. And from his mother and his father. 36. And from his wife and his children. 37. Everyman, that Day, will have enough to make him careless of others. 38. Some faces that Day, will be bright (true believers of Islamic Monotheism). 39. Laughing, rejoicing at good news (of Paradise). 40. And other faces, that Day, will be dust-stained; 41. Darkness will cover them, 42. Such will be the Kafarah (disbelievers in Allah), the Fajarah (wicked evil doers). (Abasa-42)

15. When the sun will overthrown

At-Takwir (The Overthrowing): 1. when the sun wound round and lost its light and is over thrown. 2. And when the stars shall fall. 3. And when the mountains shall made to pass away. 4. And when the pregnant she-camels shall be neglected. 5. And when the wild beasts shall be gathered together. 6. And when the seas shall become as blazing Fire or shall overflow. 7. And when the souls shall be joined with their bodies; 8. And when the female (infant) buried alive (as the pagan Arabs used to do) shall be questioned. 9. For what sin she was killed? 10. And when the written pages of deeds (good and bad) of every person shall be laid open; 11. And when the heaven shall be stripped off and taken away from its place. 12. And when Hell-fire shall be kindled to fierce ablaze. 13. And when Paradise shall be brought near, 14. (Then) every person will know what he has brought (of good and evil). (At-Takwir-14)

16. Quran is a Reminder to all

15. So verily, I swear by the planets that recede (i.e. disappear during the day and appear during the night). 16. And by the planets that move swiftly and hide themselves. 17. And by the night as it departs. 18. And by the dawn as it

brightens; 19. Verily, this is the Word (Al-Quran, brought by) a most honorable messenger (Gabriel). 20. Owner of power, and high rank with (Allah) the Lord of the Throne, 21. Obeyed (by the angels), trustworthy there (in the heavens). 22. And (O people) your companion (Muhammad -peace be upon him) is not a madman; 23. And when the graves are turned upside down (and they bring out their contents) 5. (Then) a person will know what he has sent forward and (what he has) left behind (of good or bad deeds). (AL-Infitar-5)

18. Angels are writing down our deeds

6. O man! What has made you careless concerning your Lord, the Most Generous? 7. Who created you, fashioned you perfectly, and gave you due proportion; 8. In whatever form He willed, He put you together. 9. Nay! But you deny the Recompense (reward for good deeds and punishment for evil deeds). 10. But verily, over you (are appointed angels in charge of mankind) to watch you, 11. Kiraman Katibeen (the two angels) writing down your deeds. 12. They know all that you do. (AL-Infitar-11)

19. When no one will have power to do for others

13. Verily, the Abrar (pious and righteous) will be in delight (Paradise); 14. And verily, the Fujjar (disbelievers and sinners) will be in the blazing Fire (Hell), 15. In which they will enter, and taste its burning flame on the Day of Recompense, 16. And they (Al-Fujjar) will not be absent there from (i.e. will not go out from the Hell). 17. And what will make you know what the Day of Recompense is? 18. Again, what will make you know what the Day of Recompense is? 19. (It will be) the Day when no person shall have power (to do) anything for another, and the Decision, that Day, will be (wholly) with Allah. (AL-Infitar-19)

20. Who receive full measure and give less

Al-Mutaffifin (Defrauding): 1. Woe to Al-Mutaffifin (those who give less in measure and weight). 2. *Those who, when they have to receive by measure from men, demand full measure,* 3. *And when they have to give by measure or weight to men, give less than due.* 4. Think they not that they will be resurrected (for reckoning). 5. on a Great Day. 6. The Day when (all) mankind will stand before the Lord of the Alameen (all that exists)? (Al-Mutaffifin-6)

21. Record of evil-doers is preserved

7. Nay! Truly, the Record (writing of the deeds) of the Fujjar (disbelievers, evil-doers) is (preserved) in Sijjeen. 8. And what will make you know what Sijjeen is? 9. A Register inscribed. 10. Woe, that Day, to those who deny. 11. Those who deny the Day of Recompense. 12. And none can deny it except every transgressor beyond bounds, 13. When Our Verses (of the Quran) are recited to him he says: "Tales of the ancients!" 14. Nay! But on their hearts is the Ran which they used to earn. 15. Nay! Surely, they (evil-doers) will be veiled from seeing their Lord that Day. 16. Then, verily they will indeed enter and taste the burning flame of Hell. 17. Then, it will be said to them: "This is what you used to deny!" (Al-Mutaffifin-17)

22. The pious will be in delight

18. Nay! Verily, the Record (writing of the deeds) of Al-Abrar (the pious who fear Allah), is (preserved) in Illiyyoon. 19. And what will make you know what Illiyyoon is? 20. A Register inscribed. 21. To which bear witness those nearest (to Allah, i.e. the angels). 22. Verily, Al-Abrar (the pious) will be in delight (Paradise). 23. On thrones, looking (at all things). 24. You will recognize in their faces the brightness of delight. 25. They will be given to drink pure sealed wine. 26. The last thereof (that wine) will be the smell of musk, and for this let all those strive who want to strive. 27. It (that wine) will be mixed with Tasneem. 28. A spring whereof drink those nearest to Allah. (Al-Mutaffifin-28)

23. Believers will laugh at disbelievers on doomsday

29. Verily! (During the worldly life) those who committed crimes used to laugh at those who believed. 30. And whenever they passed by them, used to wink one to another (in mockery); 31. And when they returned to their own people, they would return jesting; 32. And when they saw them, they said: "Verily! These have indeed gone astray!" 33. But they (disbelievers, sinners) had not been sent as watchers over them (the believers). 34. but this Day (the Day of Resurrection) those who believe will laugh at the disbelievers. 35. On (high) thrones, looking (at all things). 36. Are not the disbelievers paid (fully) for what they used to do? (Al-Mutaffifin-36)

24. Heaven will split and earth stretched forth

Al-Inshiqaq (Splitting Open): 1. when the heaven is split asunder. 2. And listens and obeys its Lord, and it must do so. 3. And when the earth is stretched forth. 4. And has cast out all that was in it and became empty. 5. And listens and obeys its Lord, and it must do so; 6. O man! Verily, you are returning towards your Lord with your deeds and actions (good or bad), a sure returning, so you will meet (i.e. the results of your deeds which you did). 7. Then, as for him who will be given his Record in his right hand, 8. He surely will receive an easy reckoning, 9. And will return to his family in joy! 10. But whosoever is given his Record behind his back, 11. He will invoke (his) destruction, 12. And shall enter a blazing Fire, and made to taste its burning. 13. Verily, he was among his people in joy! 14. Verily, he thought that he would never come back (to Us)! 15. Yes! Verily, his Lord has been ever beholding him! (Al-Inshiqaq-15)

25. They fall not prostrate when Quran is recited

16. So I swear by the afterglow of sunset. 17. And by the night and whatever it gathers in its darkness. 18. And by the moon when it is at the full, 19. You shall certainly travel from stage to stage (in this life and in the Hereafter). 20. What is the matter with them that they believe not? 21. *And when the Quran is recited to them, they fall not prostrate*, 22. Nay, (on the contrary), those who disbelieve, belie (Quran). 23. And Allah knows best what they gather (of good and bad deeds), 24. So announce to them a painful torment. 25. Save those *who believe and do righteous good deeds*, for them is a reward that will never come to an end (i.e. Paradise). (Al-Inshiqaq-25)

26. Allah is Witness over everything

Al-Burooj (The Mansions of the stars): 1. By the heaven, holding the big stars. 2. And by the Promised Day (Day of Resurrection). 3. And by the witnessing day, and by the witnessed day; 4. Cursed were the people of the ditch (the story of the Boy and the King). 5. Fire supplied (abundantly) with fuel. 6. When they sat by it (fire), 7. And they witnessed what they were doing against the believers. 8. They had nothing against them, except that they believed in Allah, the All-Mighty, worthy of all Praise! 9. Who, to Whom belongs the dominion of the heavens and the earth! And Allah is Witness over everything. (Al-Burooj-9)

27. Who believe and do good deeds

10. Verily, *those who put into trial the believing men and believing women, and then do not turn in repentance, (to Allah), will have the torment of Hell*, and they will have the punishment of the burning Fire. 11. Verily,

those *who believe and do righteous good deeds*, for them will be Gardens under which rivers flow (Paradise). That is the great success. (Al-Burooj-11)

28. Glorious Quran inscribed in Lauh e Mahfooz

12. Verily, the Grip (Punishment) of your Lord is severe. 13. Verily, He it is Who originates the creation of everything, and then repeats it on the Day of Resurrection. 14. And He is Oft-Forgiving, full of love. 15. Owner of the throne, the Glorious. 16. He does what He intends. 17. Has the story reached you of the hosts? 18. of Firaun (Pharaoh) and Thamood? 19. Nay! The disbelievers (persisted) in denying. 20. And Allah encompasses them from behind! 21. Nay! This is a Glorious Quran, 22. Inscribed in Al-Lauh Al-Mahfooz (The Preserved Tablet)! (Al-Burooj-22)

29. All human being has a protector over him

At-Tariq (The morning star): 1. By the heaven and At-Tariq! 2. And what will make you to know what At-Tariq (night-comer) is? 3. It is the star of piercing brightness; 4. There is no human being but has a protector over him 5. So let man see from what he is created! 6. He is created from a water gushing forth. 7. Proceeding from between the back-bone and the ribs. 8. Verily, Allah is Able to bring him back to life. (At-Tariq-8)

30. All deeds will be examined on doomsday

9. The Day when all the secrets (deeds) will be examined. 10. Then man will have no power, nor any helper. 11. by the sky (having rain clouds) which gives rain, again and again. 12. And the earth which splits (with the growth of plants), 13. Verily! This (the Quran) is the Word that separates (the truth from falsehood). 14. And it is not a thing for amusement. 15. Verily, they are but plotting a plot (against you O Muhammad - Peace be upon him). 16. And I am also planning a plan. 17. So give a respite to the disbelievers. Deal you gently with them for a while. (At-Tariq-17)

31. Allah created everything in right proportion

Al-Ala (The Most High): 1. Glorify the Name of your Lord, the Most High, 2. Who has created everything and then proportioned it. 3. And Who has measured then guided. 4. And Who brings out the pasturage, 5. And then makes it dark stubble. (Al-Ala-5)

32. Remind people if reminder profits them

6. We shall make you to recite (the Quran), so you (O Muhammad - Peace be upon him) shall not forget it, 7. except what Allah, may will. He knows what is apparent and what is hidden. 8. And We shall make easy for you the easy way. 9. Therefore remind people in case the reminder profits them. 10.

The reminder will be received by him who fears Allah. 11. But it will be avoided by the wretched, 12. Who will enter the great Fire and made to taste its burning, 13. Wherein he will neither die nor live (a good living). (Al-Ala-13)

33. Hereafter is better and more lasting

14. Indeed whosoever purifies himself (by avoiding polytheism) shall achieve success. 15. And remembers (glorifies) the Name of his Lord and prays. 16. Nay, you prefer the life of this world. 17. Although the Hereafter is better and more lasting. 18. Verily! This is in the former Scriptures. 19. The Scriptures of Ibrahim (Abraham) and Moosa (Moses) (Al-Ala-19).

34. They will enter in the hot blazing Fire

Al-Ghashiya (The Overwhelming): Has there come to you the narration of the overwhelming (Resurrection Day). 2. Some faces, that Day, will be humiliated, 3. laboring, weary. 4. They will enter in the hot blazing Fire. 5. They will be given to drink from a boiling spring, 6. No foods will there be for them but a poisonous thorny plant. 7. Which will neither nourish nor avail against hunger (Al-Ghashiya-7).

35. They will glad with their endeavor

8. Other faces, that Day, will be joyful. 9. Glad with their endeavor (for their good deeds), 10. in a lofty Paradise. 11. Where they shall neither hear harmful speech nor falsehood, 12. Therein will be a running spring, 13. Therein will be thrones raised high, 14. And cups set at hand. 15. And cushions set in rows, 16. And rich carpets all spread out. 17. Do they not look at the camels, how they are created? 18. And at the heaven, how it is raised? 19. And at the mountains, how they are rooted and fixed firm? 20. And at the earth, how it is spread out? (Al-Ghashiya-20)

36. Prophet's duty is just to remind

21. So remind them (O Muhammad - Peace be upon him)), you are only a one who reminds. 22. You are not a dictator over them. 23. But *the one who turns away and disbelieves, 24. Then Allah will punish him with the greatest punishment.* 25. Verily, to Us will be their return; 26. Then verily, for Us will be their reckoning. (Al-Ghashiya-26)

37. Who did transgress beyond bounds in the lands

Al-Fajr (The Dawn): 1. By the dawn; 2. By the ten nights (first ten days of the month of Dhul-Heejjah). 3. And by the Even and the Odd (of all the creations of Allah). 4. And by the night when it departs. 5. There is indeed in them (the above oaths) sufficient proof for men of understanding. 6. Did you (O Muhammad - Peace be upon him) not see (thought) how your Lord dealt

with Ad (people)? 7. Who were very tall like lofty pillars. 8. The like of which were not created in the land? 9. And (with) Thamood (people), who cut out rocks in the valley (to make dwellings)? 10. And (with) Firaun (Pharaoh), who had pegs (to torture men), 11. *Who did transgress beyond bounds in the lands. 12. And made therein much mischief.* 13. So your Lord poured on them different kinds of severe torment. 14. Verily, your Lord is Ever Watchful (over them). (Al-Fajr-14)

38. Treating orphans with kindness

15. As for man, when his Lord tries him by giving him honor and gifts, then he says (puffed up): "My Lord has honored me." 16. But when He tries him, by straitening his means of life, he says: "My Lord has humiliated me!" 17. Nay! *But you treat not the orphans with kindness and generosity (i.e. you neither treat them well, nor give them their exact right of inheritance)! 18. And urge not on the feeding of the poor! 19. And you devour inheritance all with greed, 20. And you love wealth with much love!* (Al-Fajr-20)

39. Allah will come with the angels in rows

21. Nay! When the earth is ground to powder! 22. And your Lord comes with the angels in rows, 23. And Hell will be brought near that Day. On that Day will man remember, but how will that remembrance then avail him? 24. He will say: "Alas! Would that I had sent forth (good deeds) for (this) my life! 25. So on that Day, none will punish as He will punish. 26. And none will bind as He will bind. (Al-Fajr-26)

40. Come back to your Lord Well-pleased

27. (It will be said to the pious): "O you the one in complete rest and satisfaction! 28. "Come back to your Lord, Well-pleased yourself and well-pleasing unto Him! 29. "Enter you, then, among My honored slaves, 30. And enter you My Paradise!" (Al-Fajr-30)

41. Verily mankind created into hardship

Al-Balad (The City): 1. I swear by this city (Makkah); 2. And you are free in this city (Makkah), 3. And by the begetter (Adam) and that which he begot (Adam's offspring); 4. Verily, We have created man into hardship. 5. Thinks he, that none can overcome him? 6. He says (boastfully): "I have wasted wealth in abundance!" 7. Thinks he, that none sees him? (Al-Balad-7)

42. Freeing Slave and giving food to poor

8. Have We not made for him a pair of eyes? 9. And a tongue and a pair of lips? 10. And shown him the two ways (good and evil)? 11. But he has made no effort to pass on the path that is steep. 12. And what will make you know the path that is steep? 13. *It is Freeing a slave 14. or giving food in a day of*

hunger (famine). 15. To an orphan near of kin. 16. Or to a Miskeen (poor) afflicted with misery. 17. Then he became one of those who believed, and recommended one another to perseverance and patience, and also recommended one another to pity and compassion. 18. They are those on the Right Hand (the dwellers of Paradise), 19. But those who disbelieved in Our Ayat (proofs, evidences, verses, lessons, signs, revelations, etc.), they are those on the Left Hand (the dwellers of Hell). 20. The Fire will be shut over them. (Al-Balad-20)

43. Who purifies and corrupts his own-self

Ash-Shams (The Sun): 1. And by the sun and its brightness; 2. And by the moon as it follows it (the sun). 3. And by the day as it shows up (the sun's) brightness. 4. And by the night as it conceals it (the sun); 5. And by the heaven and Him Who built it; 6. And by the earth and Him Who spread it, 7. And by Nafs (a person), and Him Who perfected him in proportion; 8. Then He showed him what is wrong for him and what is right for him. 9. *Indeed he succeeds who purifies (from evil deeds) his own-self. 10. And indeed he fails who corrupts his own-self (by doing evil deeds).* (Ash-Shams-10)

44. Thamood killed she-camel of Allah

11. Thamood (people) denied (their Prophet) through their transgression (by rejecting the true Faith). 12. When the most-wicked man among them went forth (to kill the she-camel). 13. But the Messenger of Allah (Salih) said to them: "Be cautious! Fear the evil end. That is the she-camel of Allah! (Do not harm it) and bar it not from having its drink!" 14. Then they denied him and they killed it. So their Lord destroyed them because of their sin, and made them equal in destruction! 15. And He (Allah) feared not the consequences thereof. (Ash-Shams-15)

45. Charity makes smooth path of ease

Al-Lail (The night): 1. By the night as it envelops; 2. And by the day as it appears in brightness; 3. And by Him Who created male and female; 4. Certainly, your efforts and deeds are diverse (different in aims and purposes). 5. As for him *who gives (in charity) and keeps his duty to Allah and fears Him. 6. And believes in Al-Husna. 7. We will make smooth for him the path of ease (goodness). 8. But he who is greedy miser and thinks himself self-sufficient. 9. And gives the lie to Al-Husna . 10. We will make smooth for him the path for evil; 11. And what will his wealth benefit him when he goes down (in destruction).* (Al-Lail-11)

46. It is Allah, who guides

12. Of course, it is undertaken by Us (Allah) to guide 13. And truly, unto Us belong the last (Hereafter) and the first (this world). 14. Therefore I have

warned you of a Fire blazing fiercely (Hell); 15. None shall enter it save the most wretched, 16. Who denies and turns away. 17. And Al-Muttaqoon (the pious) will be far removed from it (Hell). 18. He who spends his wealth for increase in self-purification, 19. And he has no favor from anyone for which a reward is expected in return. 20. except only the desire to seek the Countenance of his Lord, the Most High; 21. He surely will be pleased (when he will enter Paradise). (Al-Lail-21)

47. Oppress not orphans and repulse not beggars

Ad-Dhuha (The morning hours): 1. By the forenoon (after sun-rise). 2. And by the night when it is still (or darkens); 3. Your Lord (O Muhammad, Peace be upon him) has neither forsaken you nor hated you. 4. And indeed the Hereafter is better for you than the present (life of this world). 5. And verily, your Lord will give you (all good) so that you shall be well-pleased. 6. Did He not find you (O Muhammad, Peace be upon him) an orphan and gave you a refuge? 7. And He found you unaware (Prophet hood) and guided you? 8. And He found you poor, and made you rich? 9. Therefore, *treat not the orphan with oppression, 10. And repulse not the beggar; 11. And proclaim the Grace of your Lord.* (Ad-Dhuha-11)

48. There is relief with the hardship

Al-Inshirah (Solace): 1. Have We not opened your breast for you (O Muhammad, Peace be upon him)? 2. And removed from you your burden, 3. Which weighed down your back? 4. And raised high your fame? 5. So verily, with the hardship, there is relief, 6. Verily, with the hardship, there is relief. 7. *So when you have finished (from your occupation), then stand up for Allahs worship.* 8. And to your Lord (Alone) turn (all your intentions and hopes and) your invocations. (Al-Inshirah-8)

49. Allah created mankind of best stature

At-Tin (The Fig): 1. By the fig and the olive, 2. By Mount Sinai! 3. And by this city of security (Makkah). 4. Verily, We created man of the best stature (mould), 5. Then We reduced him to the lowest of the low, 6. Save those who believe and do righteous deeds, then they shall have a reward without end (Paradise). 7. Then what causes you to deny the Recompense (Day of Resurrection)? 8. Is not Allah the Best of judges? (At-Tin-8)

50. Allah has taught by the Pen

Al-Alaq (The Clot): 1. Read! In the Name of your Lord, Who has created (all that exists). 2. Has created man from a clot (a piece of thick coagulated blood). 3. Read! And your Lord is the Most Generous 4. Who has taught (the writing) by the pen. 5. Has taught man that which he knew not. (Al-Alaq-5)

51. Man considers himself as self-sufficient.

6. Nay! Verily, man does transgress all bounds (in disbelief and evil deeds). 7. Because he considers himself self-sufficient. 8. Surely! Unto your Lord is the return. 9. Have you seen him *who prevents 10. a slave when he prays?* 11. Tell me, if he (Muhammad, Peace be upon him) is on the guidance (of Allah)? 12. Or enjoins piety? 13. Tell me if he (the disbeliever) denies (Quran), and turns away? 14. Knows he not that Allah does see (what he does)? 15. Nay! If he ceases not, We will catch him by the forelock, 16. A lying, sinful forelock! 17. Then, let him call upon his council (of helpers), 18. We will call the guards of Hell (to deal with him)! 19. Nay! Do not obey him. Fall prostrate and draw near to Allah! (Al-Alaq-19)

52. Al-Qadr night is better than 1000 months

Al-Qadr (The Power): 1. Verily! We have sent it (Quran) down in the night of Al-Qadr (Decree) 2. And what will make you know what the night of Al-Qadr is? 3. The night of Al-Qadr is better than a thousand months. 4. Therein descend the angels and the Rooh (Gabriel) by Allahs Permission with all Decrees, 5. Peace! (from Allah to His believing slaves) until the appearance of dawn. (Al-Qadr-5)

53. Worship Allah, perform Salat and give Zakat

Al-Bayyina (The Clear proof): 1. Those who disbelieve from among the people of the Scripture (Jews and Christians) and among Al-Mushrikoon, were not going to leave (their disbelief) until there came to them clear evidence. 2. A Messenger (Muhammad, Peace be upon him) from Allah, reciting (the Quran) purified pages. 3. Containing correct and straight laws from Allah. 4. And the people of the Scripture (Jews and Christians) differed not until after there came to them clear evidence. 5. And they were commanded not, but that they should *worship Allah, and worship none but Him Alone, and perform As-Salat (prayers) and give Zakat: and that is the right religion.* (Al-Bayyina-5)

54. Jews and Christians are the worst of creatures

6. Verily, those who disbelieve (the Quran) from among the people of the Scripture (Jews and Christians) and Al-Mushrikoon will abide in the Fire of Hell. They are the worst of creatures. 7. Verily, those who believe and do righteous good deeds, they are the best of creatures. 8. Their reward with their Lord is Adn (Eden) Paradise (Gardens of Eternity), underneath which rivers flow, they will abide therein forever, Allah Well-Pleased with them, and they with Him. That is for him who fears his Lord. (Al-Bayyina-8)

55. Earth will throw out its burdens

Al-Zalzala (The earthquake): 1. When the earth is shaken with its (final) earthquake. 2. And when the earth throws out its burdens, 3. And man will say: "What is the matter with it?" 4. That Day it will declare its information. 5. Because your Lord has inspired it. 6. That Day mankind will proceed in scattered groups that they may be shown their deeds. 7. So whosoever does good equal to the weight of an atom shall see it. 8. And whosoever does evil equal to the weight of an atom shall see it. (Al-Zalzala-8)

56. Man is violent in the love of wealth

Al-Adiyat (The Chargers): 1. By the racers panting! 2. Striking sparks of fire! 3. And scouring to the raid at dawn 4. And raise the dust in clouds the while. 5. Penetrating forthwith as one into the midst (of the foe); 6. Verily! *Man is ungrateful to his Lord*; 7. And to that fact he bears witness (by his deeds); 8. And verily, *he is violent in the love of wealth*. 9. Knows he not that when the contents of the graves are brought out and poured forth (all mankind is resurrected). 10. And that which is in the breasts (of men) shall be made known. 11. Verily, that Day (Day of Resurrection) their Lord will be Well-Acquainted with. (Al-Adiyat-11)

57. What the striking Event is?

Al-Qaria: 1. The striking Event! 2. What is the striking Event? 3. And what will make you know what the striking Event is? 4. It is a Day whereon mankind will be like moths scattered about, 5. And the mountains will be like carded wool, 6. Then as for him whose balance (of good deeds) will be heavy, 7. He will live a pleasant life (in Paradise). 8. But as for him whose balance (of good deeds) will be light, 9. He will have his home in Hawiyah (pit of. Hell). 10. And what will make you know what it is? 11. It is a hot blazing Fire! (Al-Qaria-11)

58. Competition in worldly increase till death

At-Takathur: 1. Competition in worldly increase diverts you, 2. Until you visit the graves. 3. Nay! You shall come to know! 4. Again, Nay! You shall come to know! 5. Nay! if you knew with a sure knowledge. 6. Verily, You shall see the blazing Fire (Hell)! 7. And again, you shall see it with certainty of sight! 8. Then, on that Day, you shall be asked about the delight. (At-Takathur-8)

59. Who is not in loss?

Al-Asr: 1. By Al-Asr (the time). 2. Verily! Mankind is in loss, 3. Except those who believe (in Quran) and do righteous good deeds, and recommend one another to the truth and recommend one another to patience. (Al-Asr-3)

60. Woe to every slanderer and backbiter

Al-Humaza: 1. Woe to every slanderer and backbiter. 2. Who has gathered wealth and counted it, 3. He thinks that his wealth will make him last forever! 4. Nay! Verily, he will be thrown into the crushing Fire. 5. And what will make you know what the crushing Fire is? 6. The fire of Allah, kindled. 7. Which leaps up over the hearts. 8. Verily, it shall be closed in on them, 9. In pillars stretched forth. (Al-Humaza 9)

61. How Allah dealt with the Elephant army

Al-Fel (The Elephant): 1. Have you (O Muhammad, Peace be upon him) not seen how your Lord dealt with the Owners of the Elephant? (Abraham's elephant army came from Yemen intending to destroy the Kabah at Makkah). 2. Did He not make their plot go astray? 3. And sent against them birds, in flocks. 4. Striking them with stones of Sijjeel. 5. And made them like eaten straw. (Al-fil-5)

62. They must worship the Lord Kabah

Quraish: 1. Because of the familiarity of the Quraish, 2. That is, their familiarity with the trips of winter and summer, 3. They must worship the Lord of this House (the Kabah in Makkah). 4. Who gave them food against hunger, and gave them security against fear. (Quraish-4)

63. Deny people common necessity items

Al-Maun: 1. Have you seen him who denies the Recompense? 2. That is he *who repulses the orphan harshly. 3. And urges not the feeding of the needy. 4. So woe unto those performers of Salat, 5. Who delay their Salat from their stated fixed times. 6. Those who do good deeds only to be seen (of men), 7. And deny people the articles of common necessity.* (Al-Maun-7)

64. Turn in prayer and sacrifice

Al-Kauthar: 1. Verily, We have granted you (O Muhammad, Peace be upon him) Al-Kauthar (a river in Paradise); 2. Therefore *turn in prayer to your Lord and sacrifice* (to Him only). 3. Surely it is your (O Muhammad, Peace be upon him) enemy, whose traces are cut off. (Al-Kauthar-3)

65. Religions of believers and disbelievers

Al-Kafiroon (The Disbelievers): 1. Say (O Muhammad, Peace be upon him) O Disbelievers! 2. I worship not that which you worship. 3. Nor will you worship that which I worship. 4. And I shall not worship that which you are worshipping. 5. Nor will you worship that which I worship. 6. To you be your religion, and to me my religion. (Al-Kafiroon-6)

66. Praises of your Lord and ask for Forgiveness

An-Nasr (The Succor): 1. When comes the Help of Allah (to you, O Muhammad, Peace be upon him) and the conquest (of Makkah), 2. And you see that the people enter Allah's religion (Islam) in crowds, 3. So glorify the *Praises of your Lord, and ask for His Forgiveness*. Verily, He is the One Who accepts the repentance and forgives. (An-Nasr-3)

67. Perish the hands of Aboo Lahab

Al-Masadd / Lahab:: 1. Perish the two hands of Aboo Lahab (Prophet's uncle), and perish he! 2. His wealth, which he gained, will not benefit him! 3. He will burn in a Fire of blazing flame! 4. And his wife too, who carries fire-wood. 5. Upon her neck shall be a rope of palm-fiber. (Al-Masadd-5)

68. Allah is in need of none

Al-Ikhlās: 1. Say: He is Allah, the one and unique. 2. Allah, the Eternal Refuge. 3. He neither begot anyone, nor was he begotten. 4. And none is comparable to Him." (Al-Ikhlās-4)

69. Seek refuge from the evil of the envier

Al-Falaq: 1. Say: I seek refuge with (Allah) the Lord of the daybreak. 2. from the evil of what He has created. 3. And from the evil of the darkening (night) as it comes with its darkness. 4. "And from the evil of the witchcrafts when they blow in the knots. 5. And from the evil of the envier when he envies. (Al-Falaq-5)

70. Seek refuge from the evil of the whisperer

An-Nas: 1. Say: "I seek refuge with (Allah) the Lord of mankind, 2. The King of mankind, 3. The Ilah (God) of mankind, 4. From the evil of the whisperer who withdraws (when Allah's name is pronounced), 5. Who whispers in the breasts of mankind 6. Whether from among the Jinn or Mankind (An-Nas-6)



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
